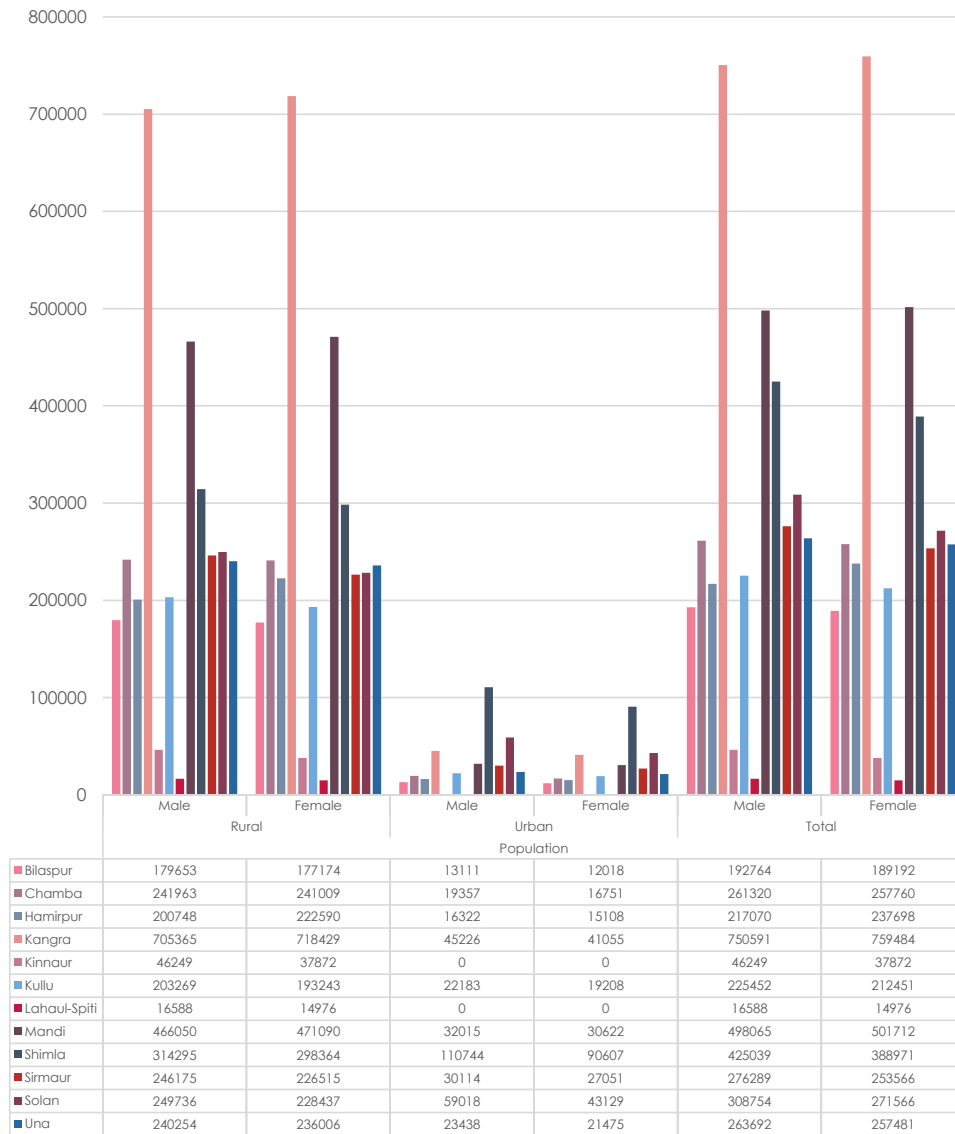
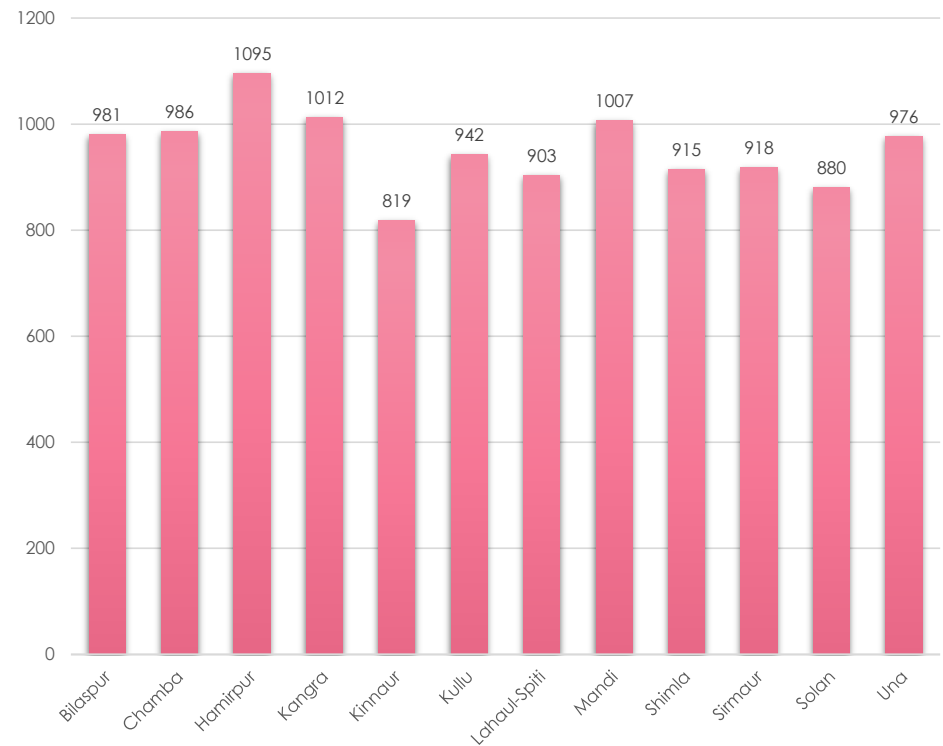


Area, Density and Decennial Growth of Population in Different District



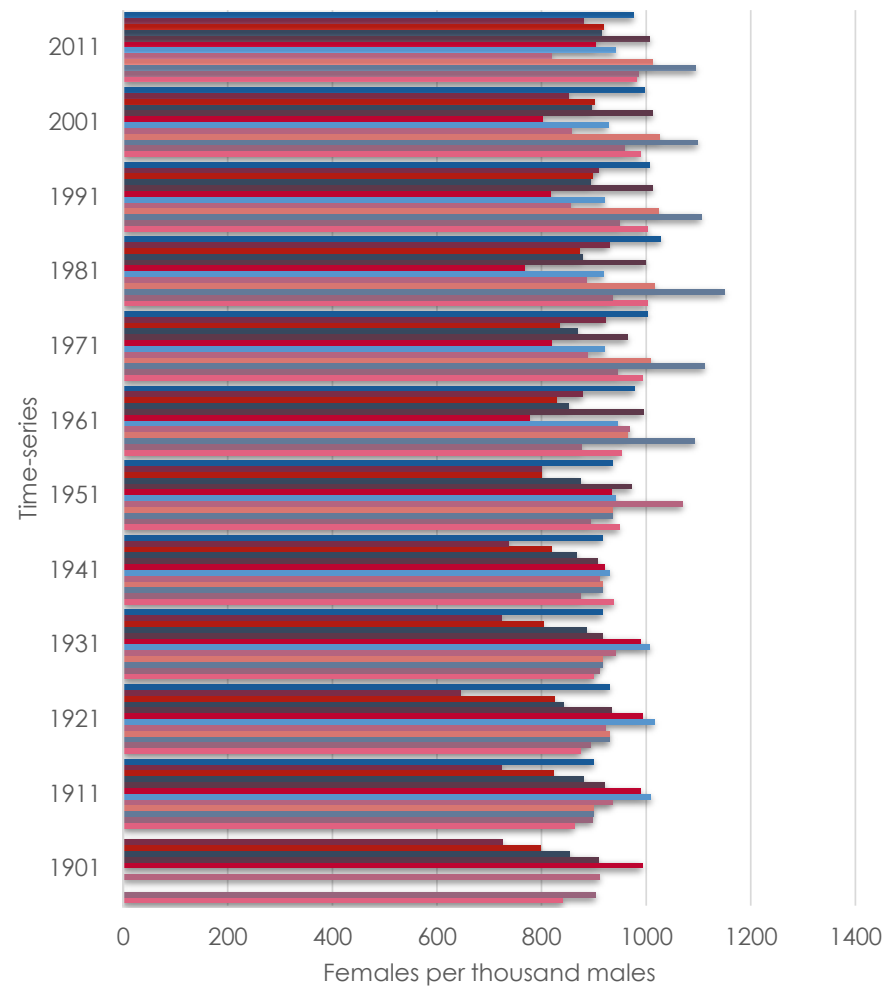
Sex-wise Rural-Urban Population-2011 Census

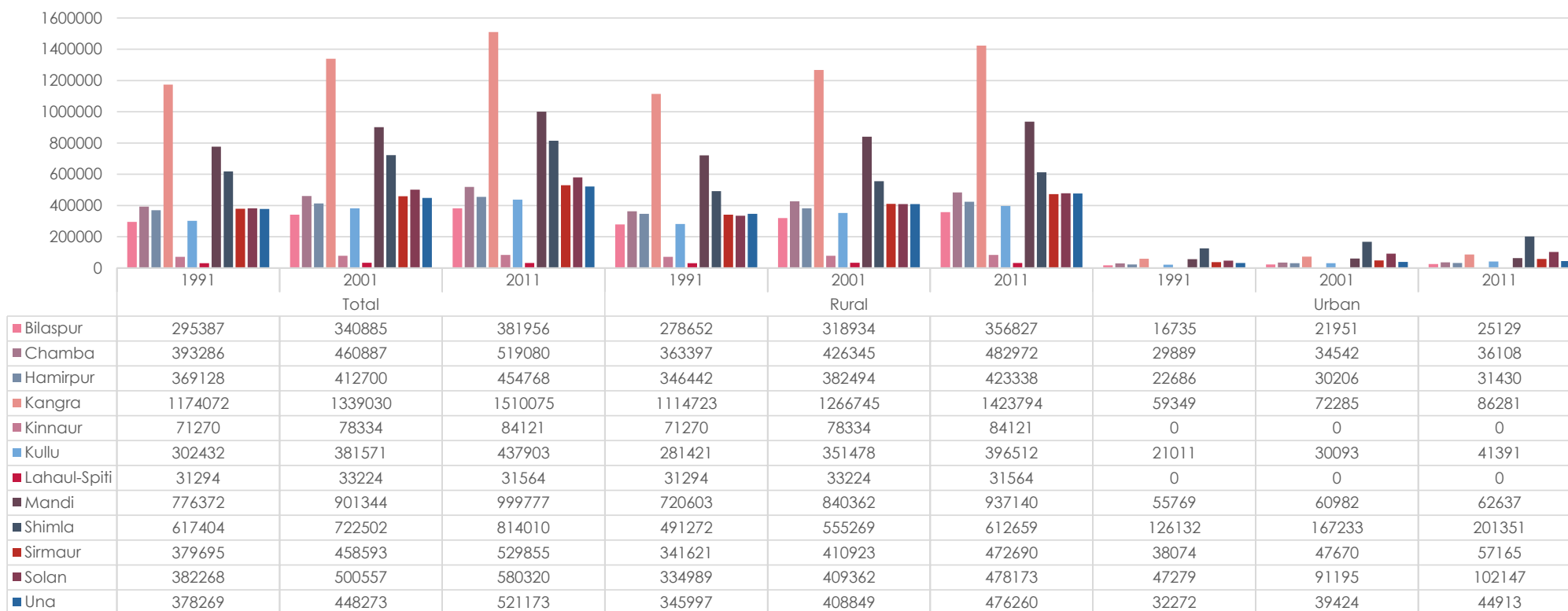


District-wise Sex Ratio in Himachal Pradesh

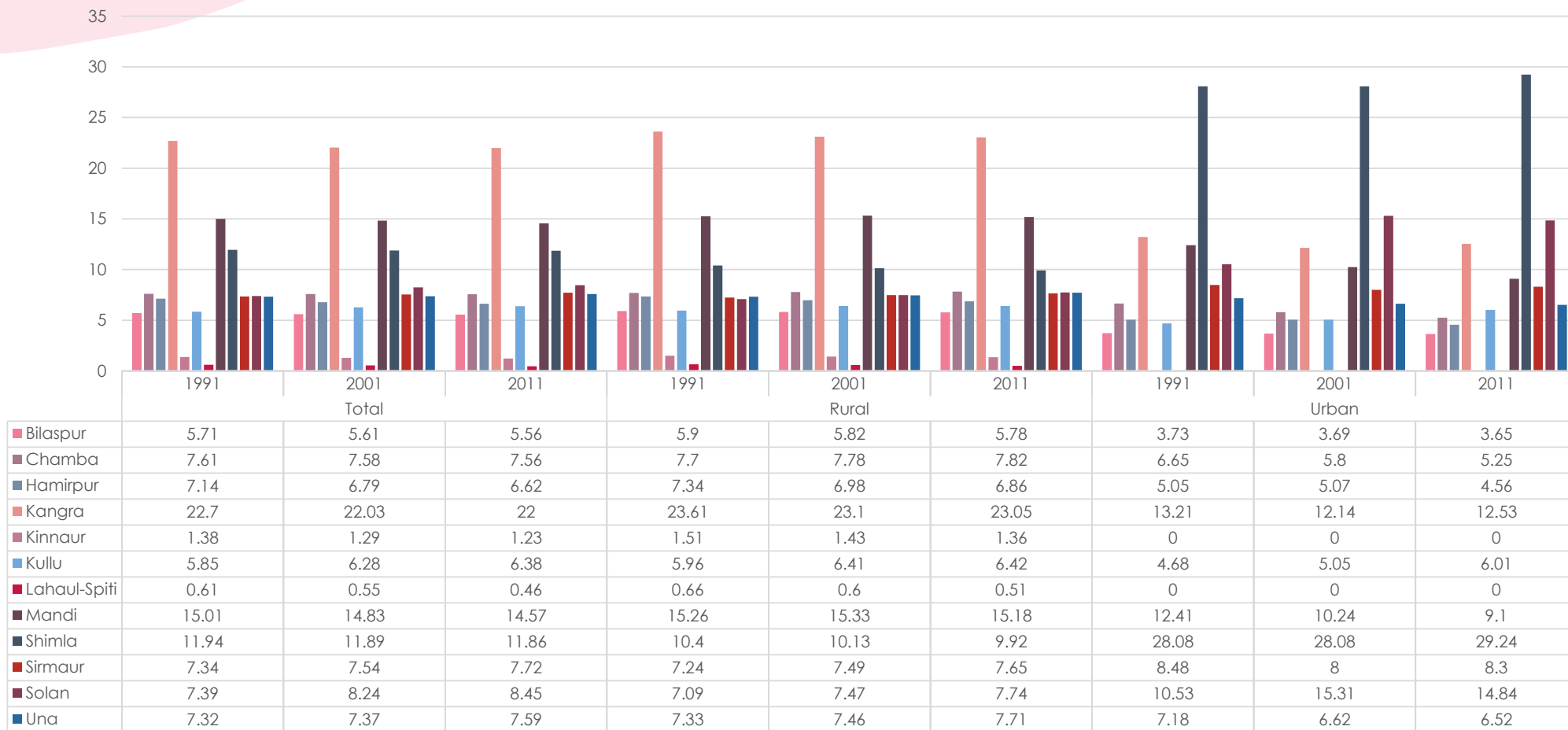

District-wise Decennial Population of Himachal Pradesh (1991, 2001 and 2011 Census)

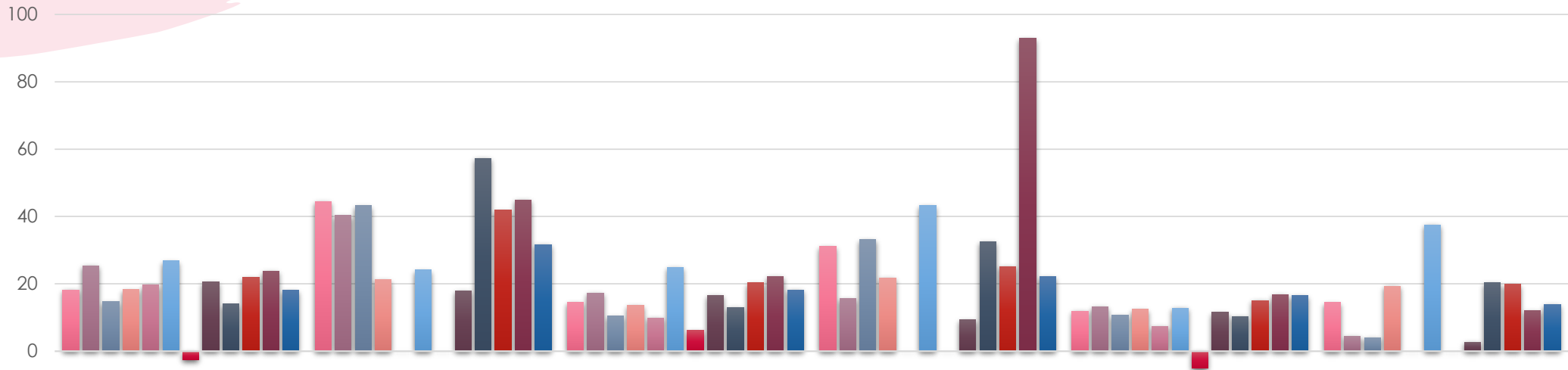


District-wise Percentage of Rural/Urban Population



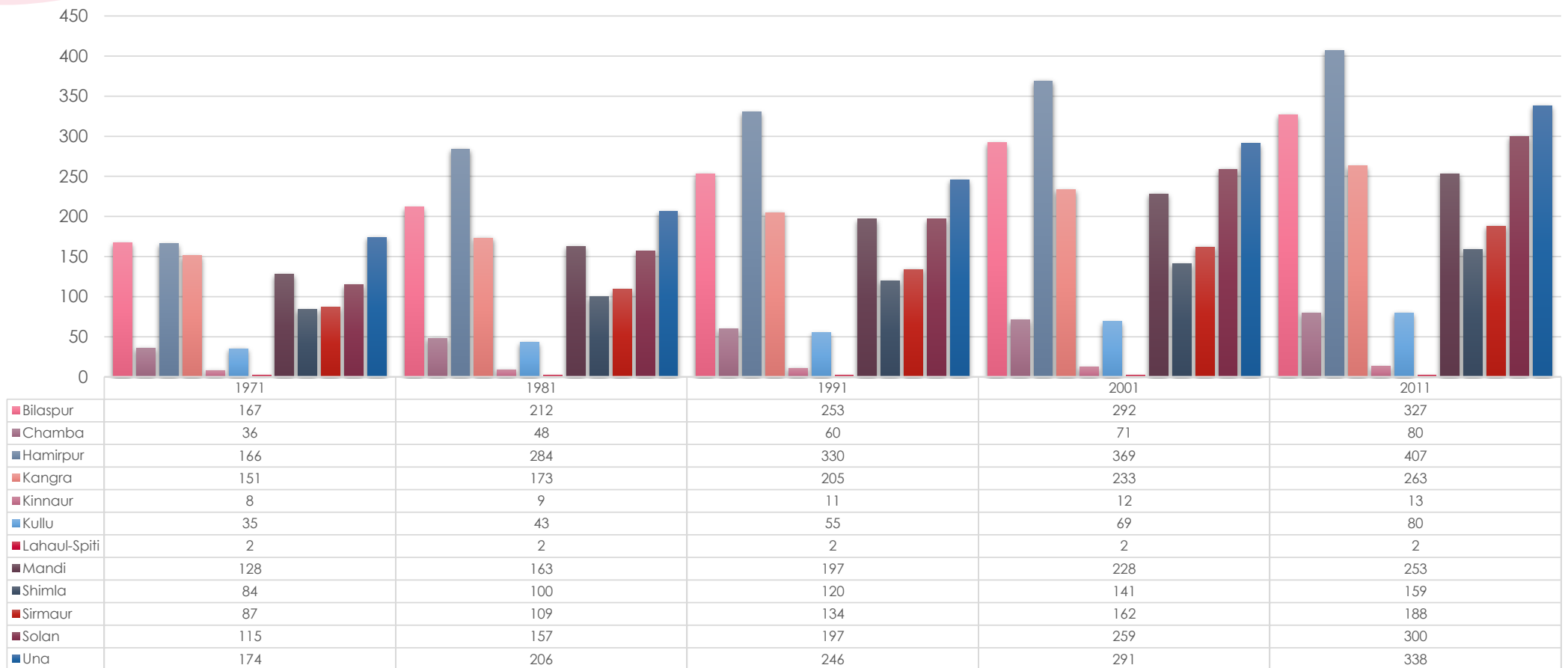

District-wise Decadal Growth Rate



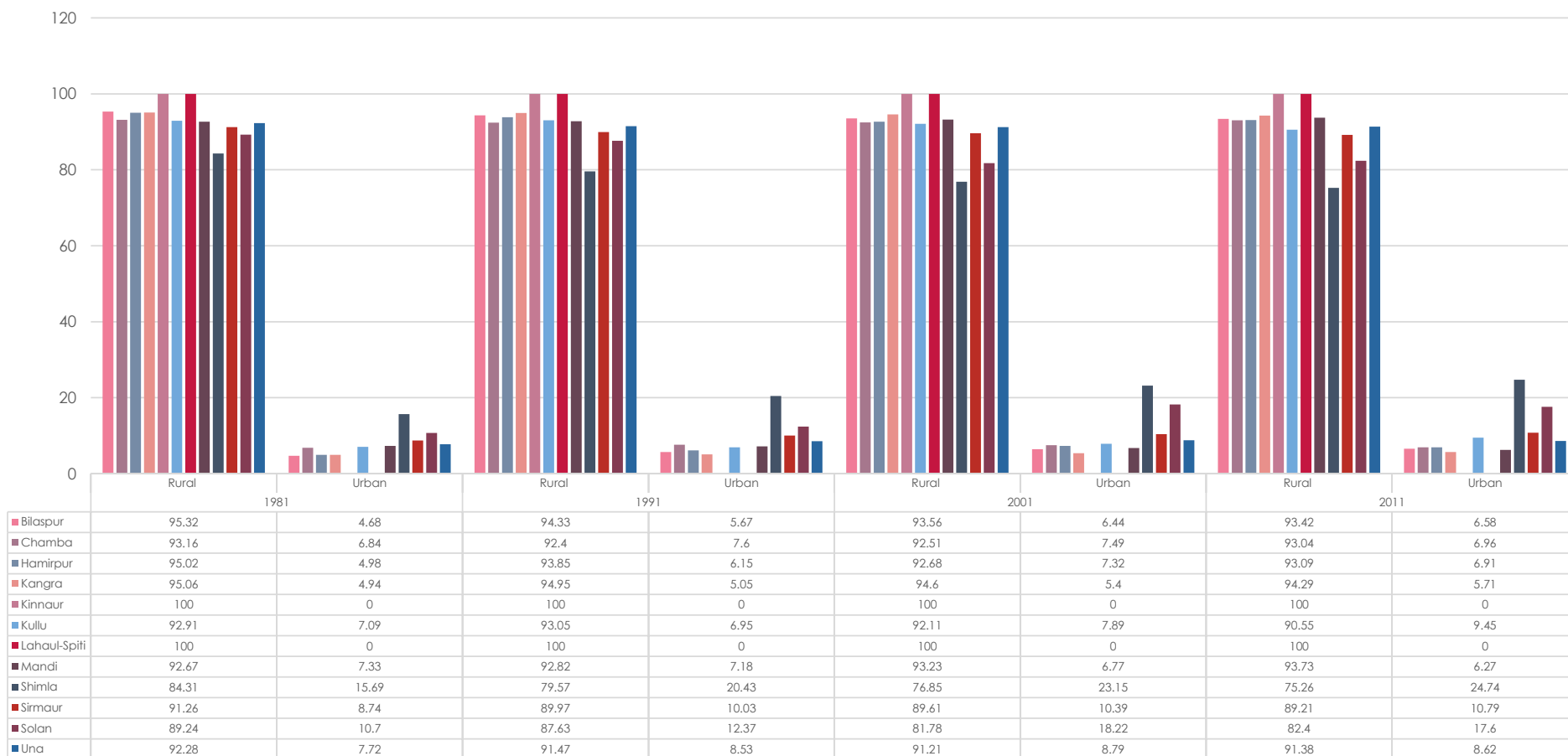

District-wise Area and Density of Population

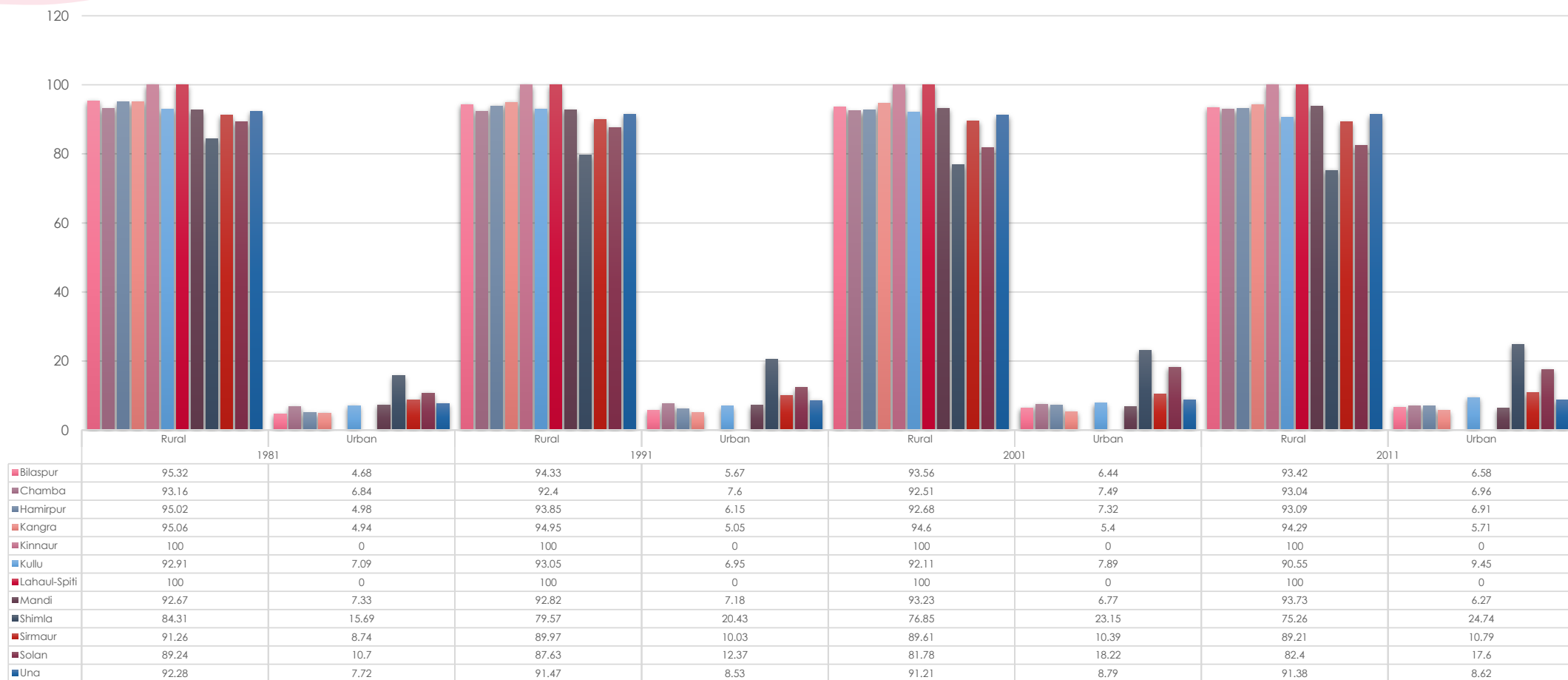


Rural-Urban Population as Percentage to Total Population of the Districts

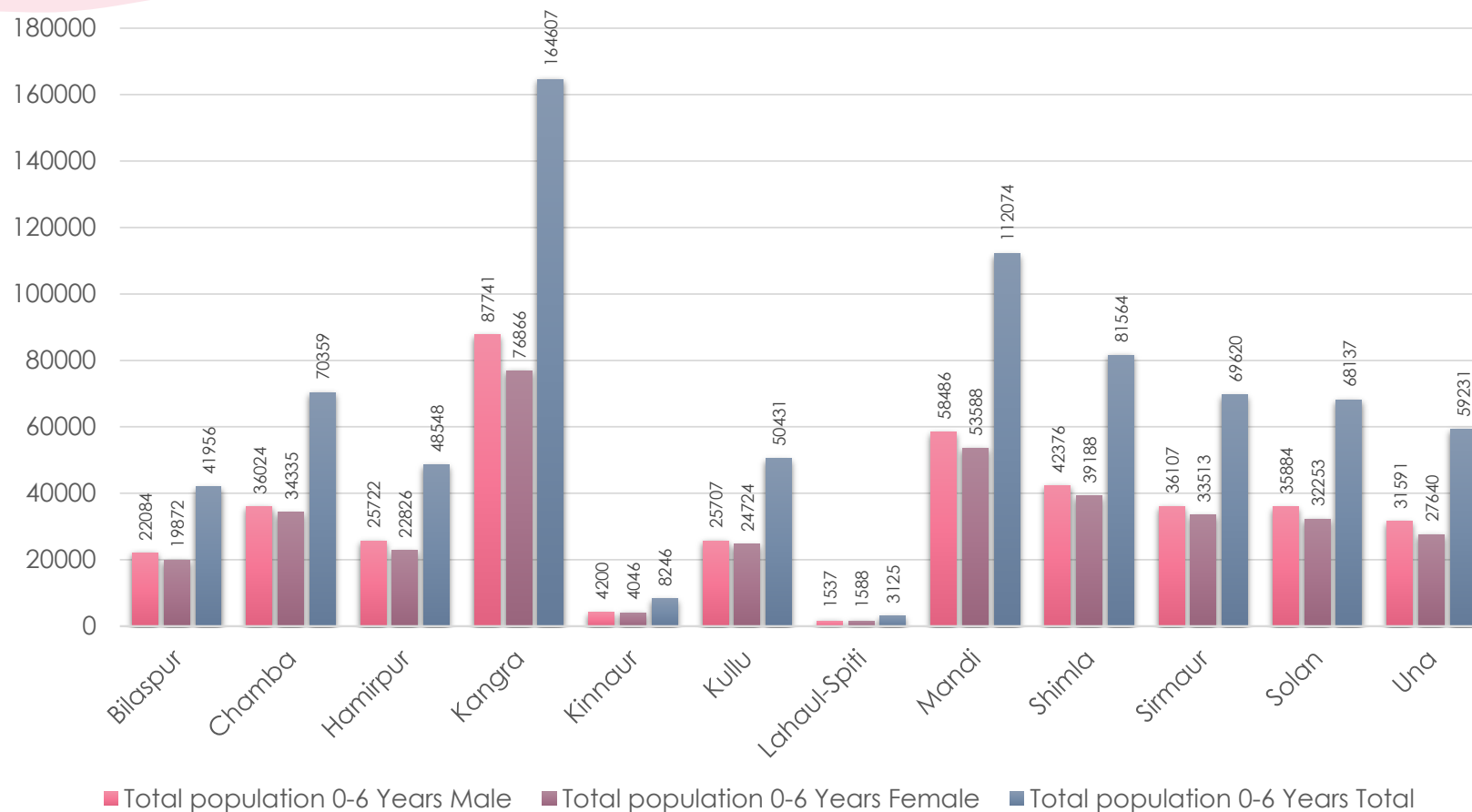

District/Sex wise 0-6 Years Population and their percentage **Census-2011**



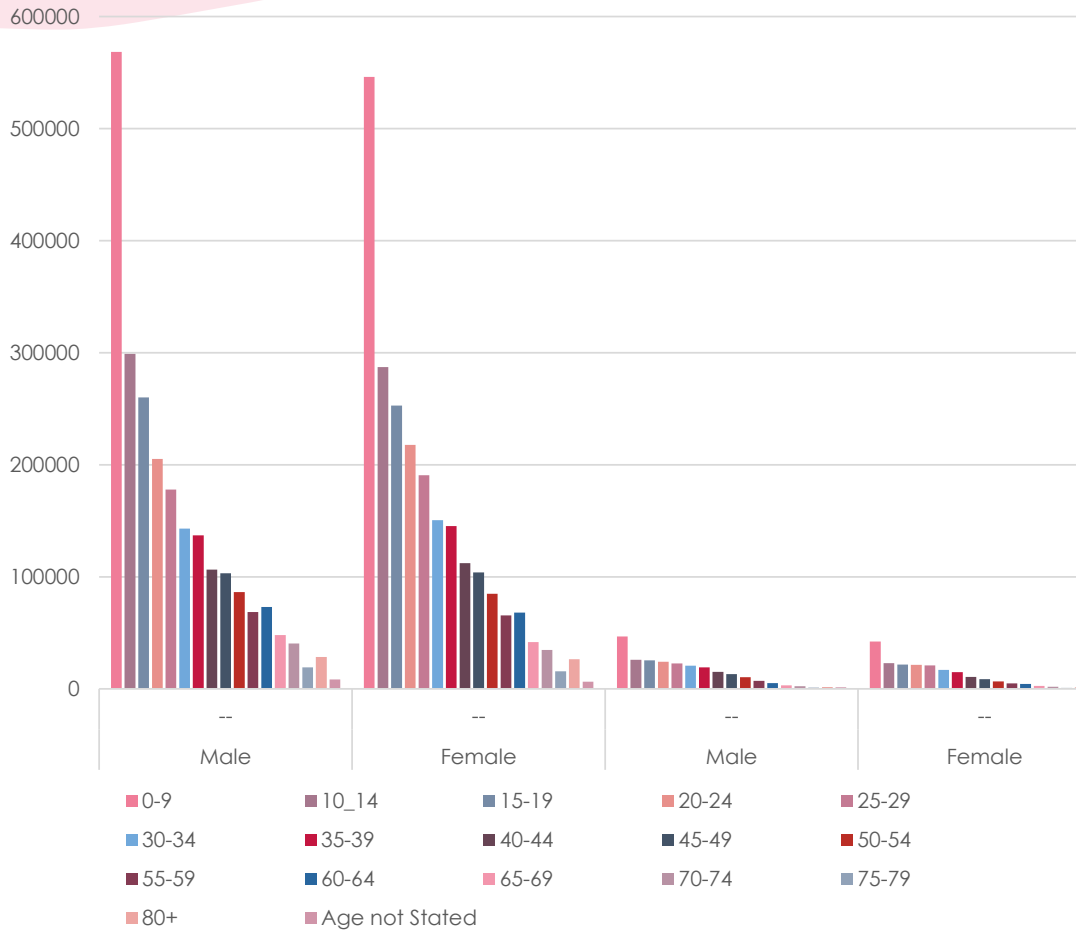

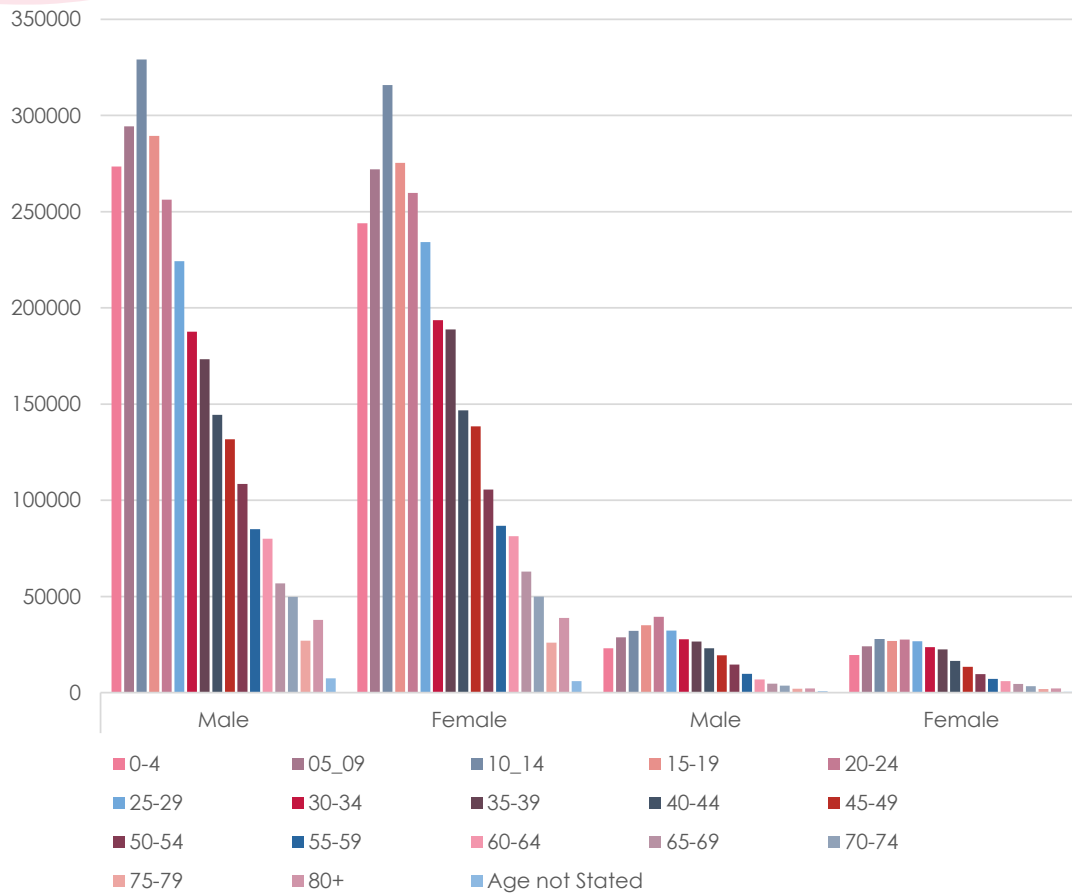

Age-wise Distribution of H.P. Population 1991 Census



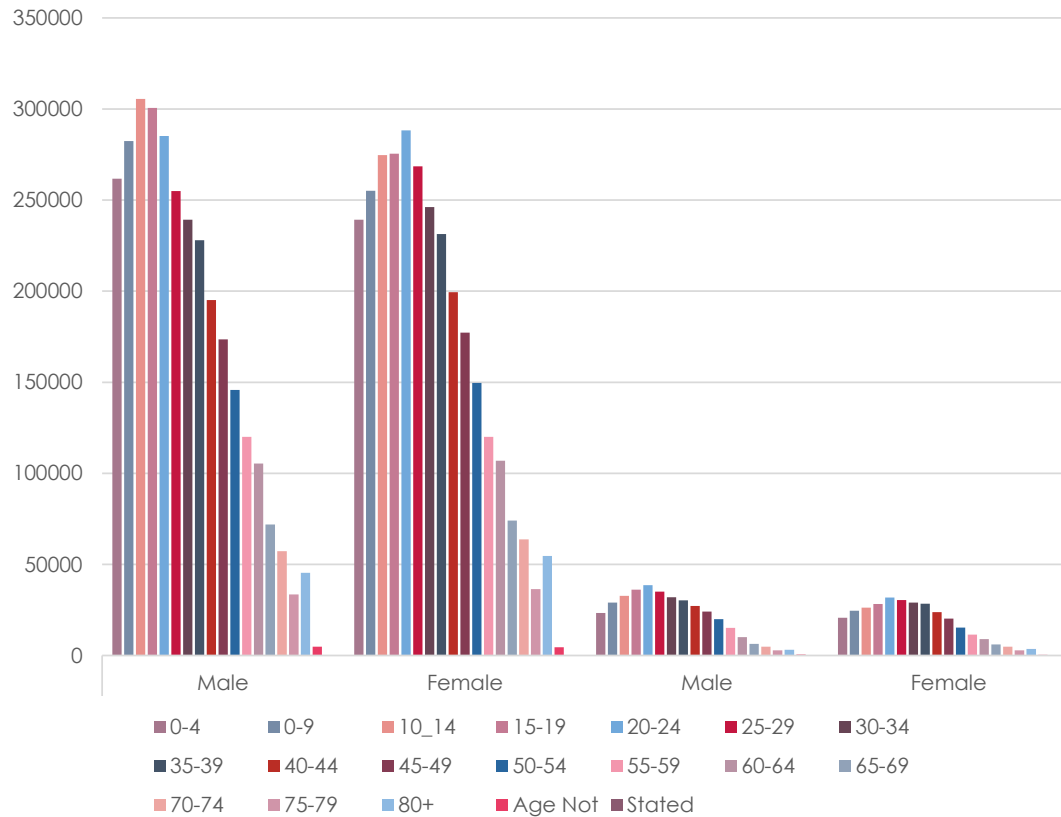

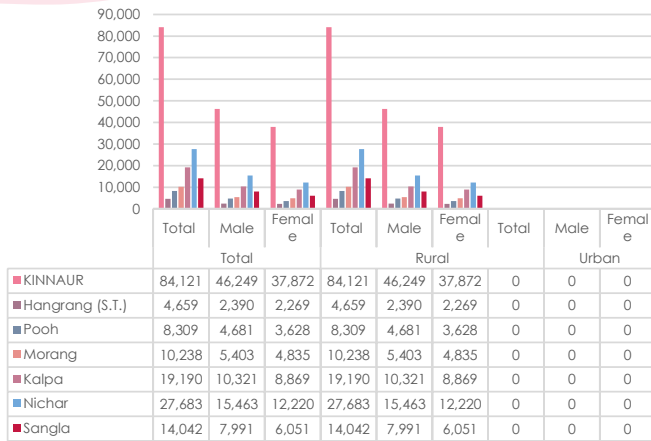

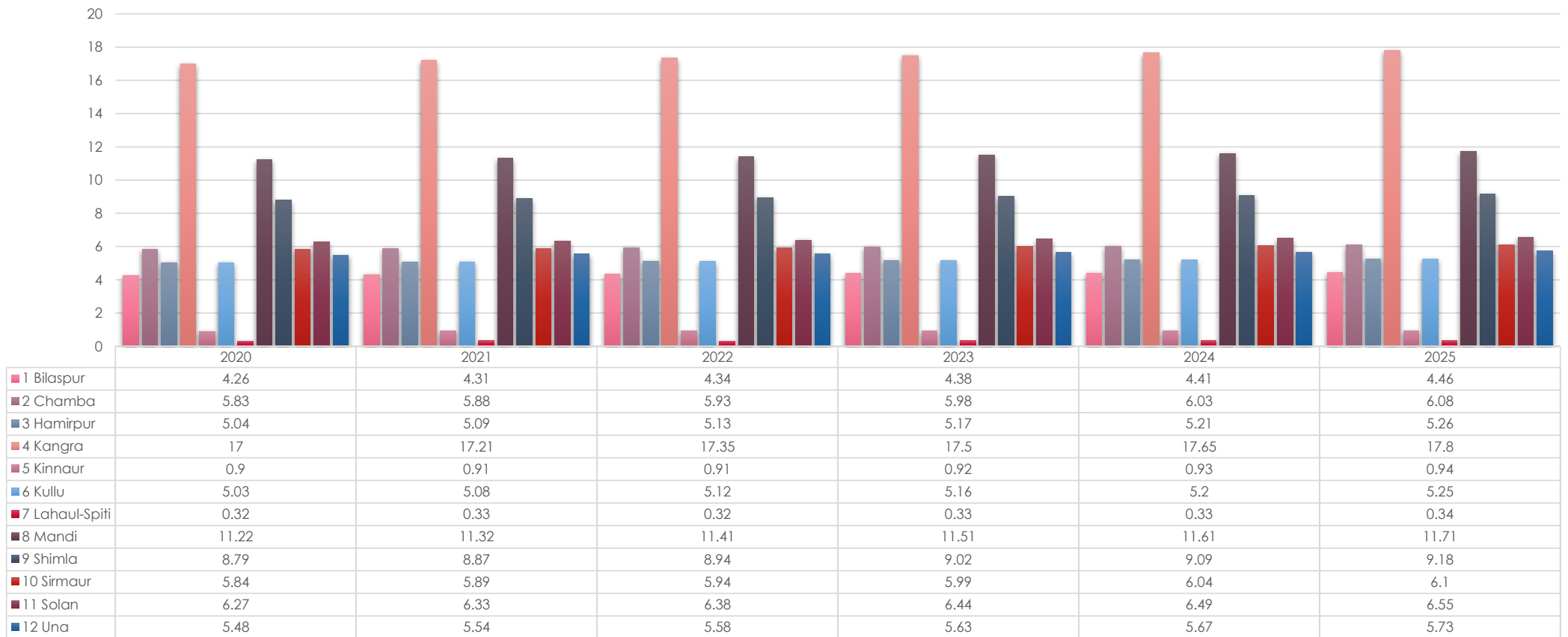

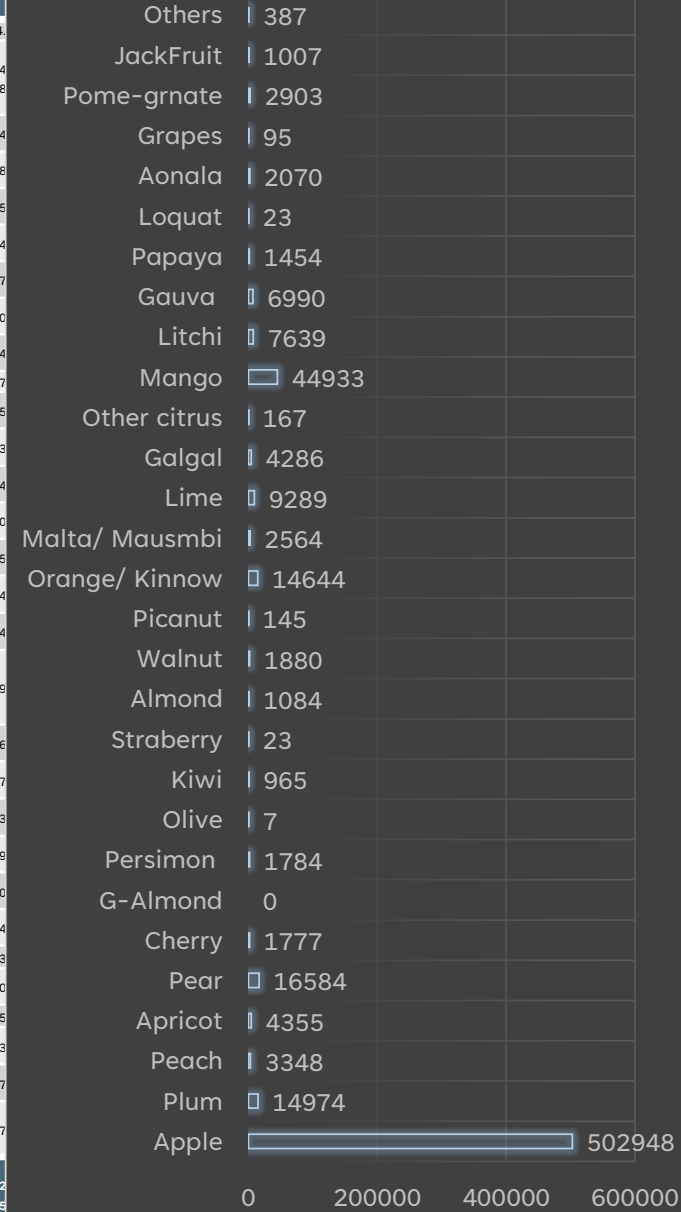


PRODUCTION OF FRUITS 2023-24 (IN M. TONNES)

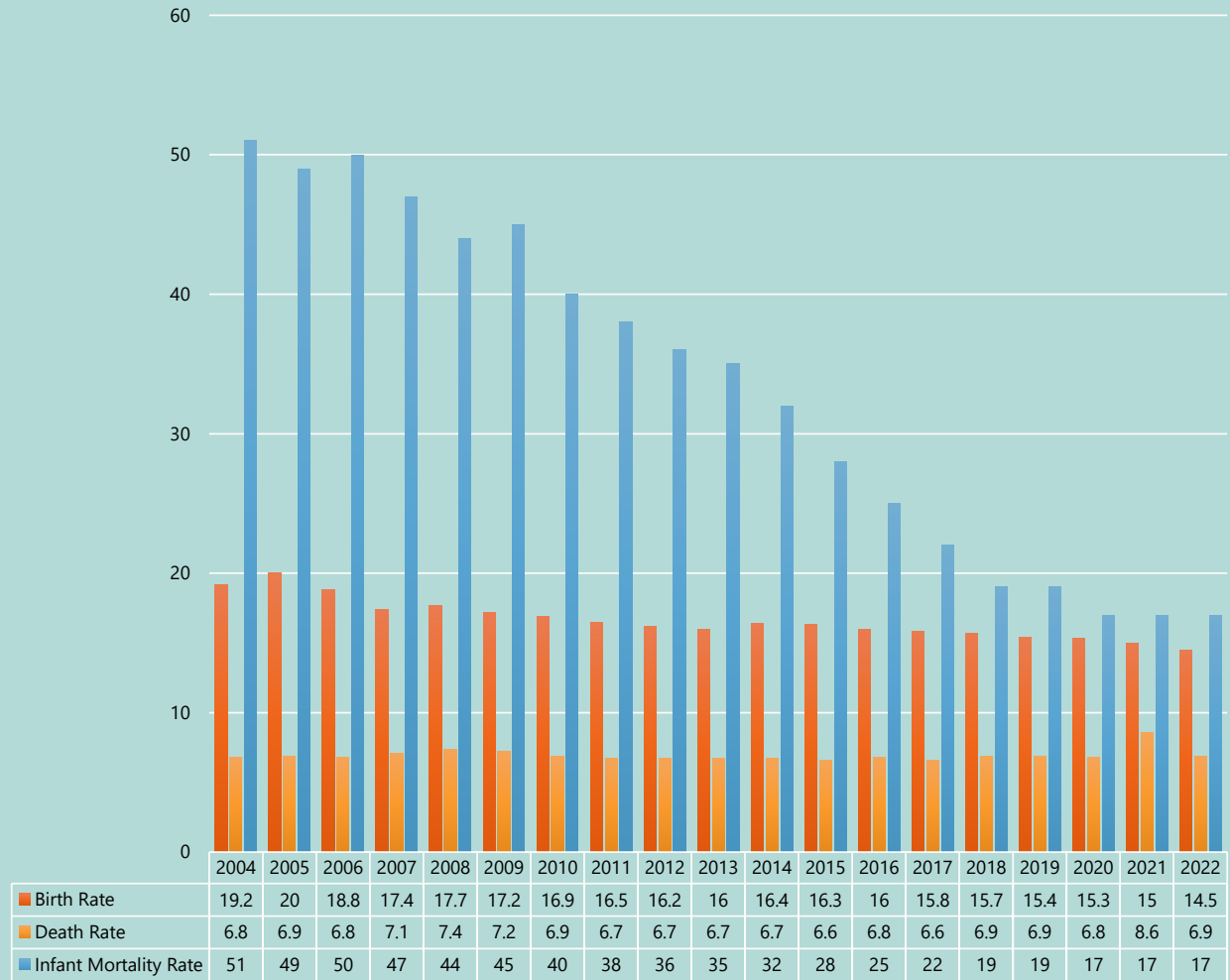
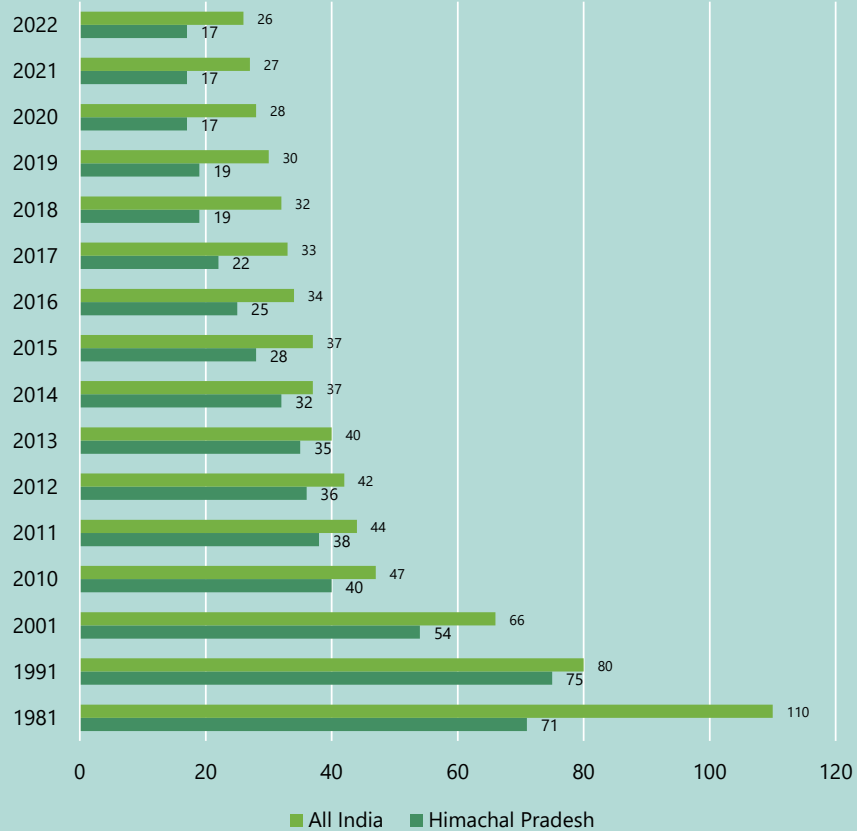


Birth and Death Rate in Himachal Pradesh

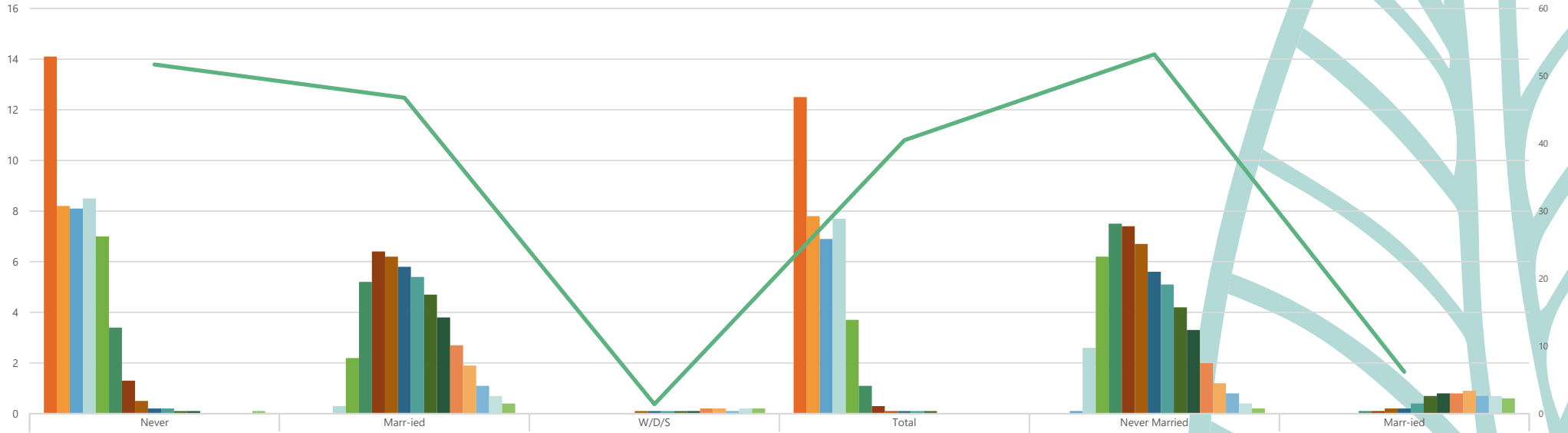

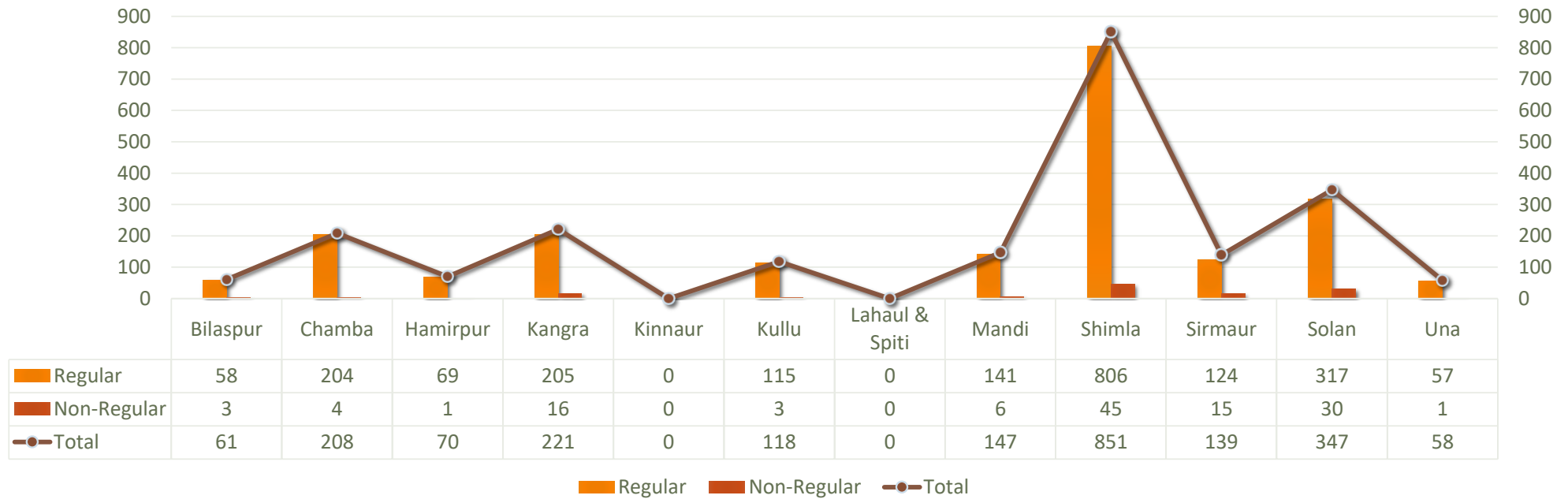
Distribution of Himachal Pradesh Government (Non-Regular) Employees in H.P.

District-wise Distribution of Public Undertaking Regular and Non-Regular Employees in H.P.





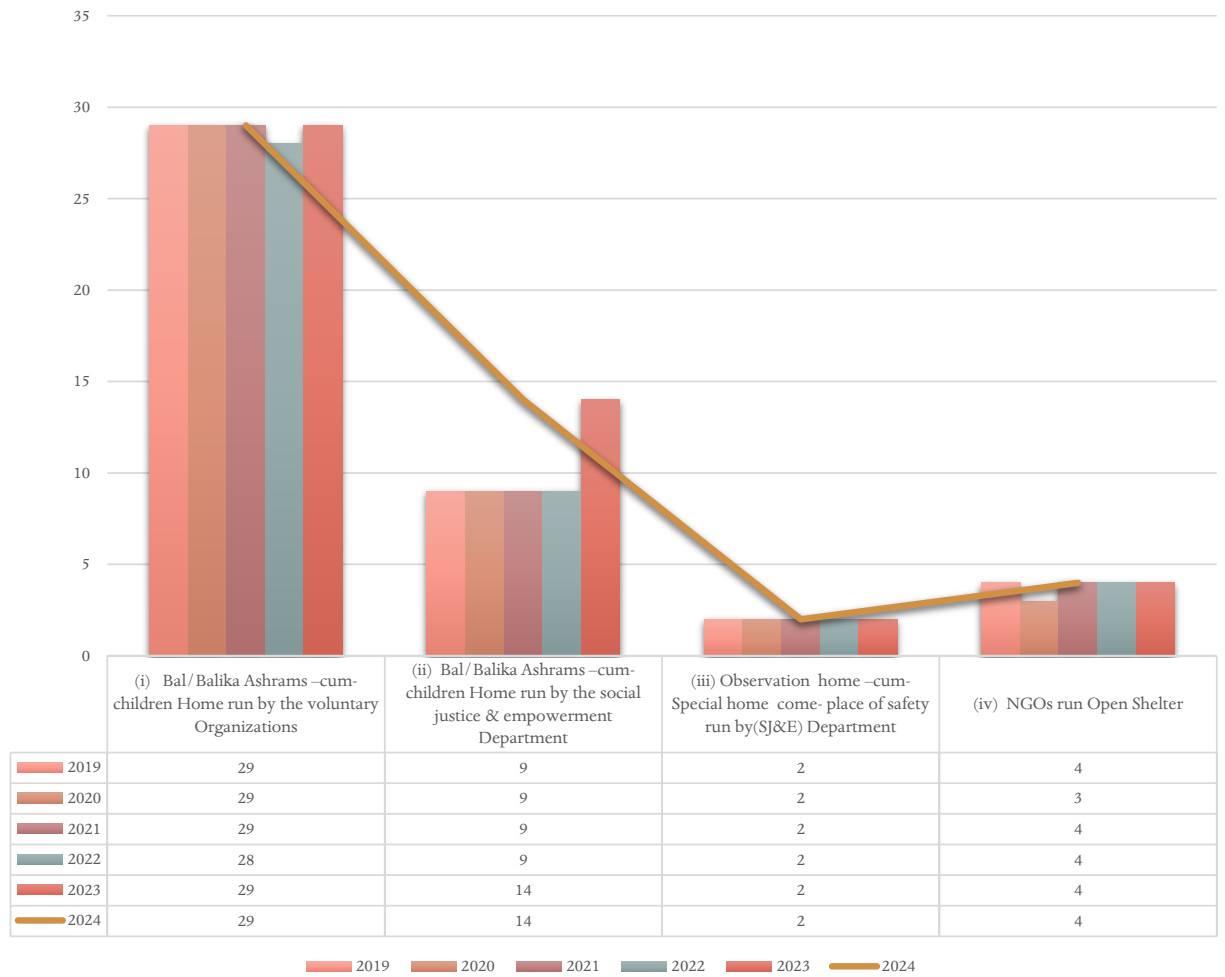
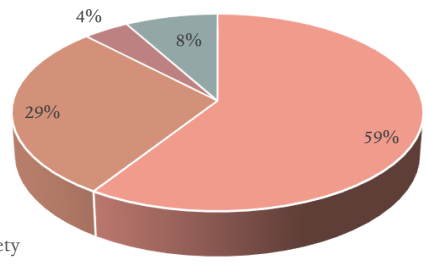

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE(GROSS AND NET)



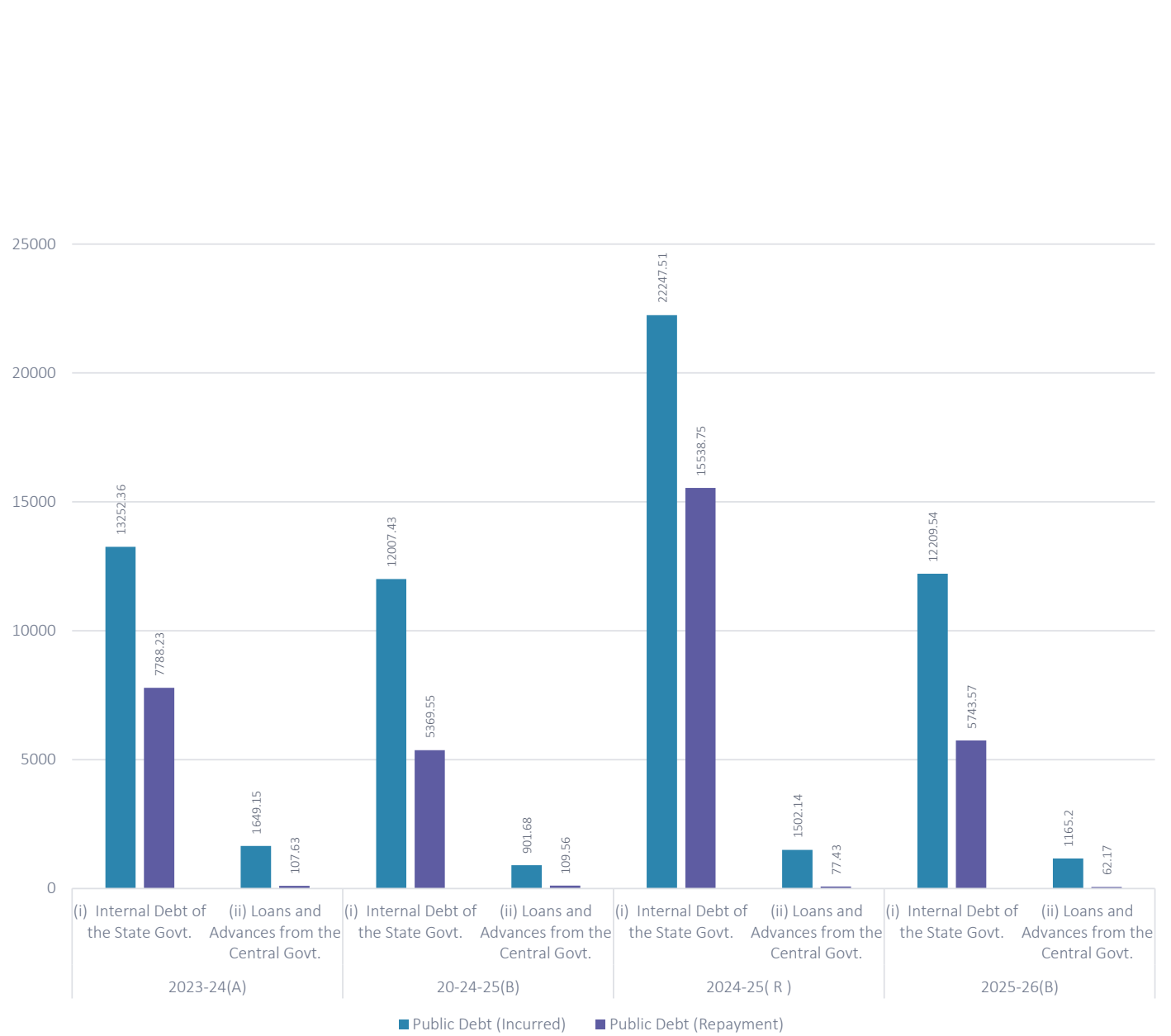
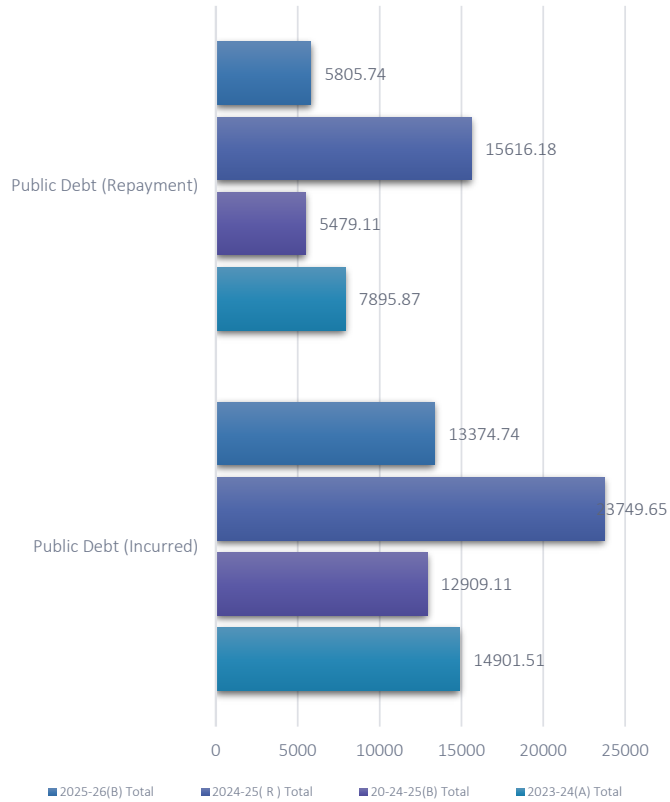

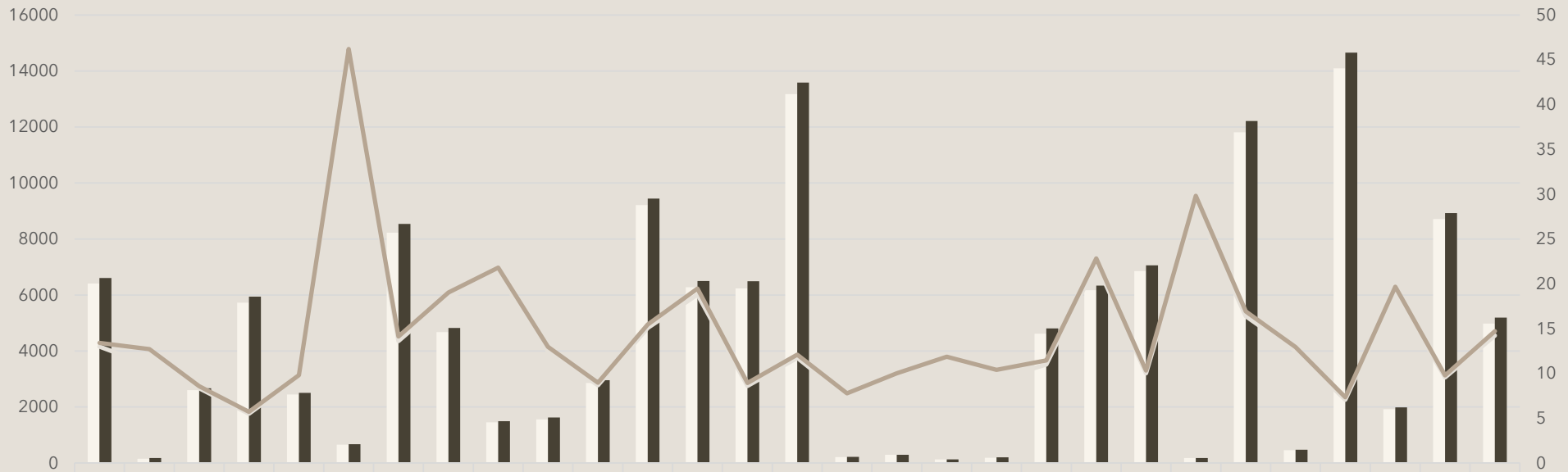
DEPOSITS AND CREDIT RATIO OF SCHEDULED COMMERCIAL BANKS- MARCH, 2025

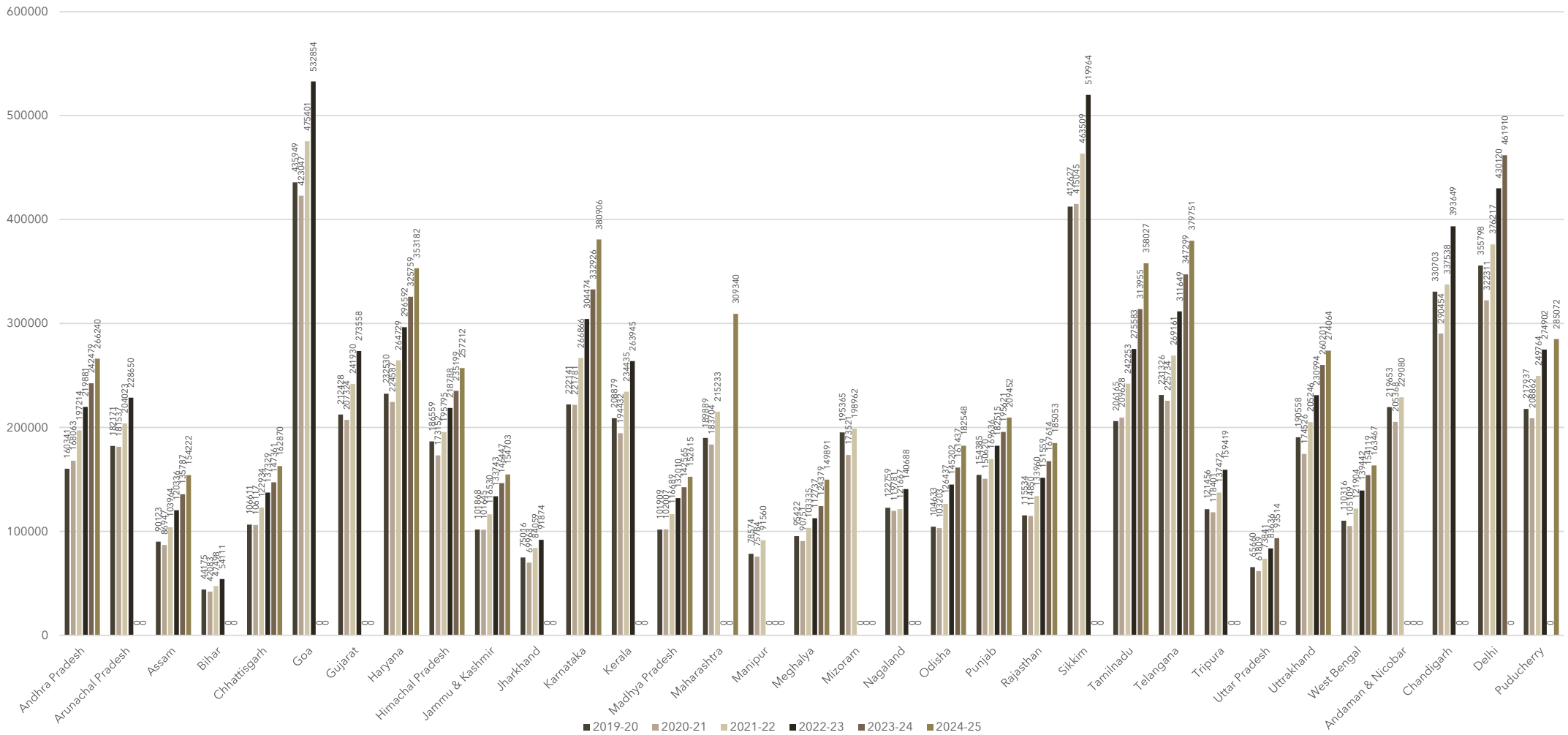

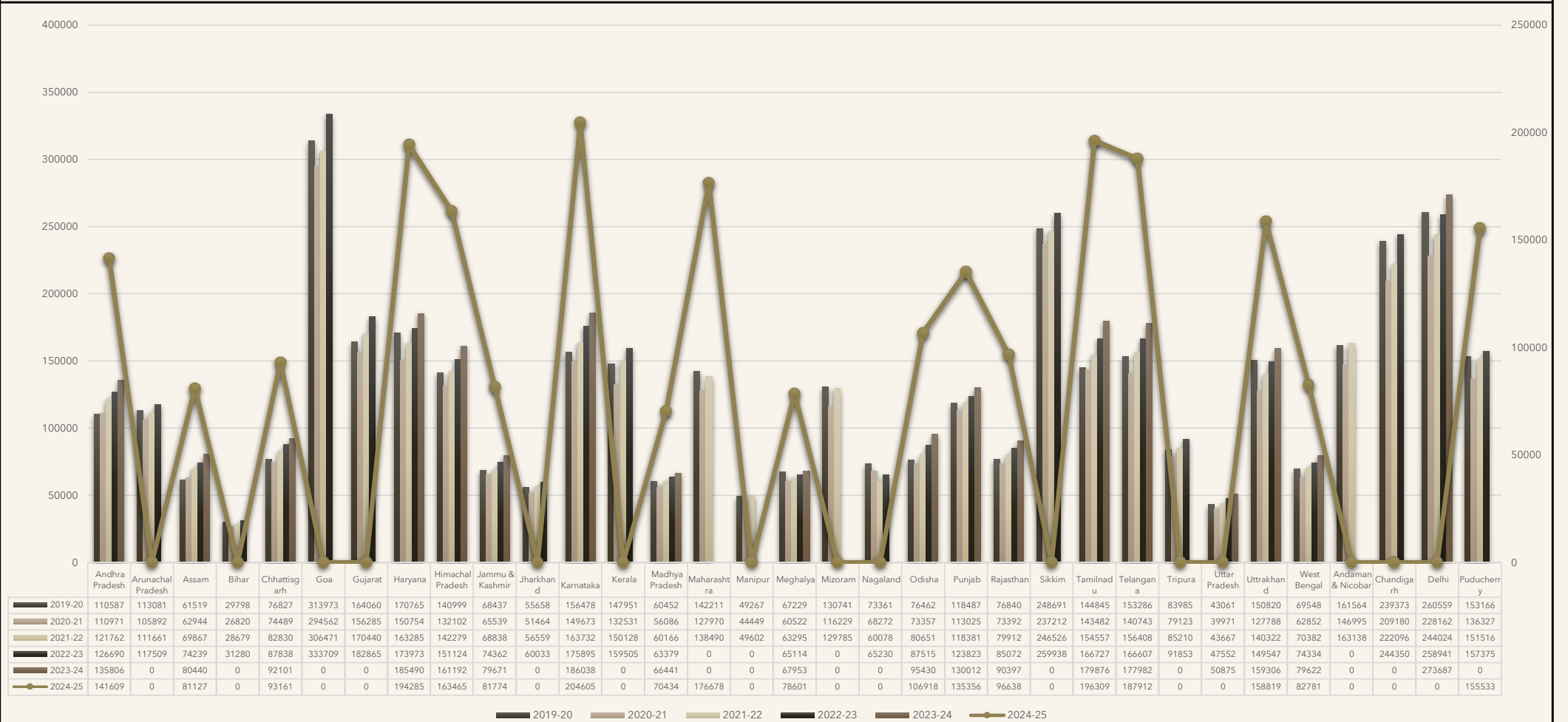
PER CAPITA INCOME (STATE-WISE) IN INDIA

(AT CURRENT PRICES BASE 2011-12)

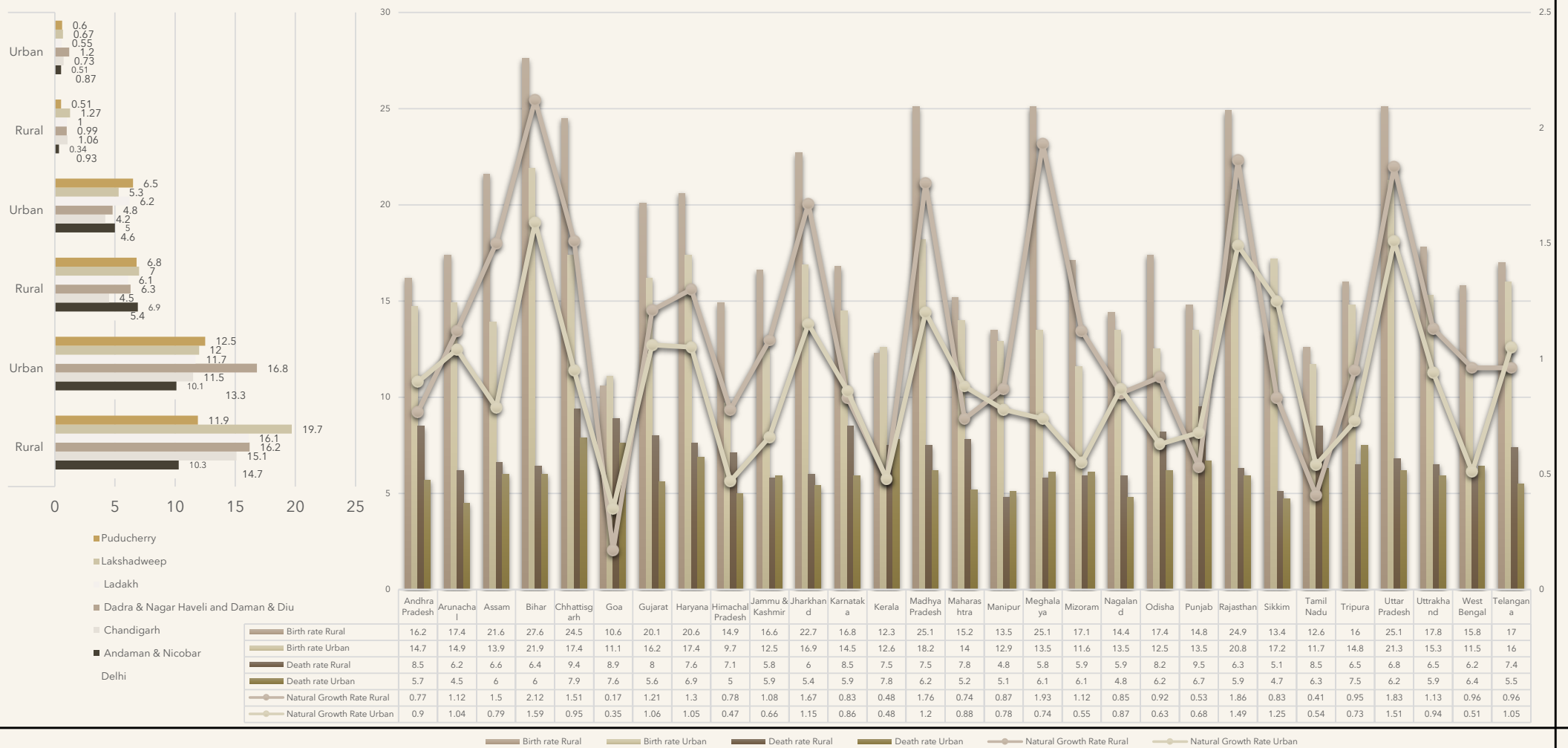

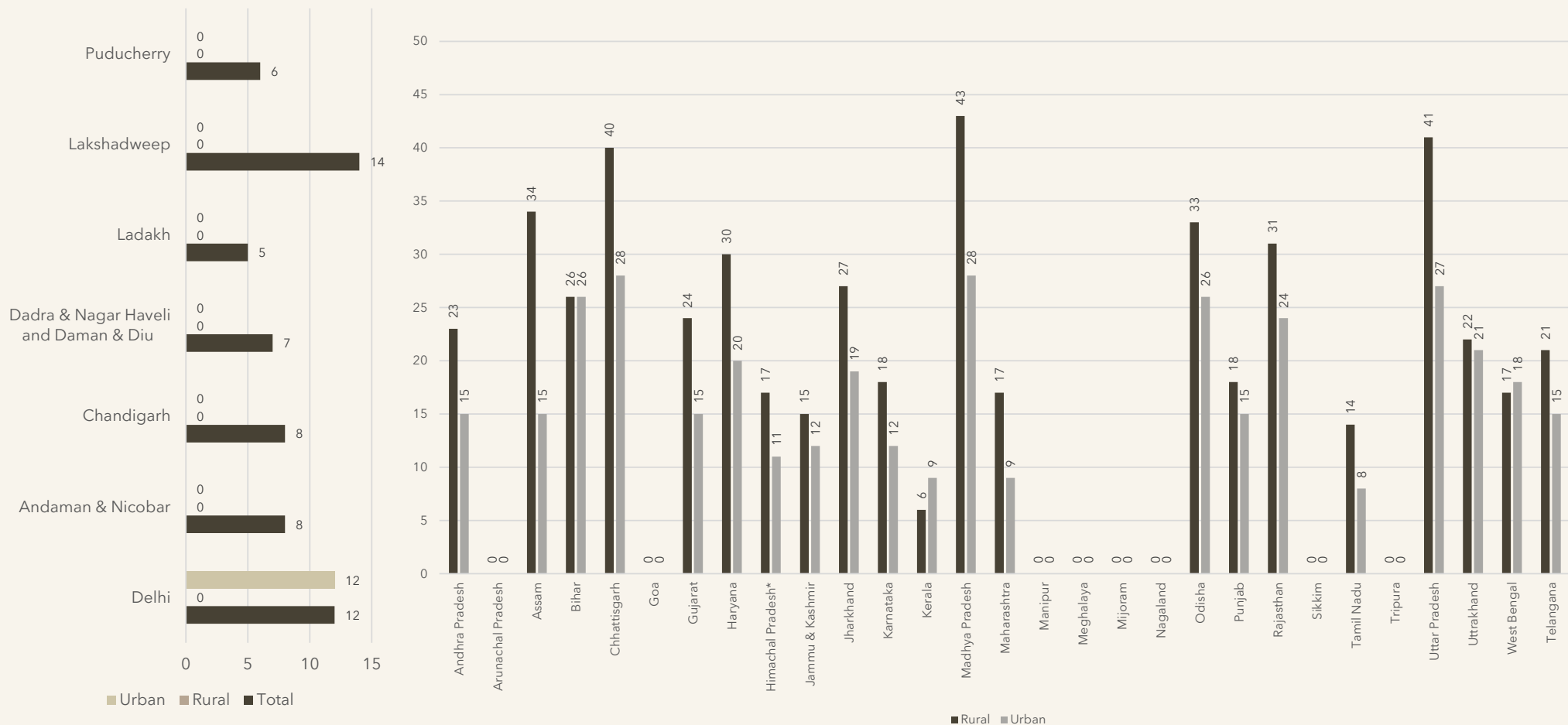

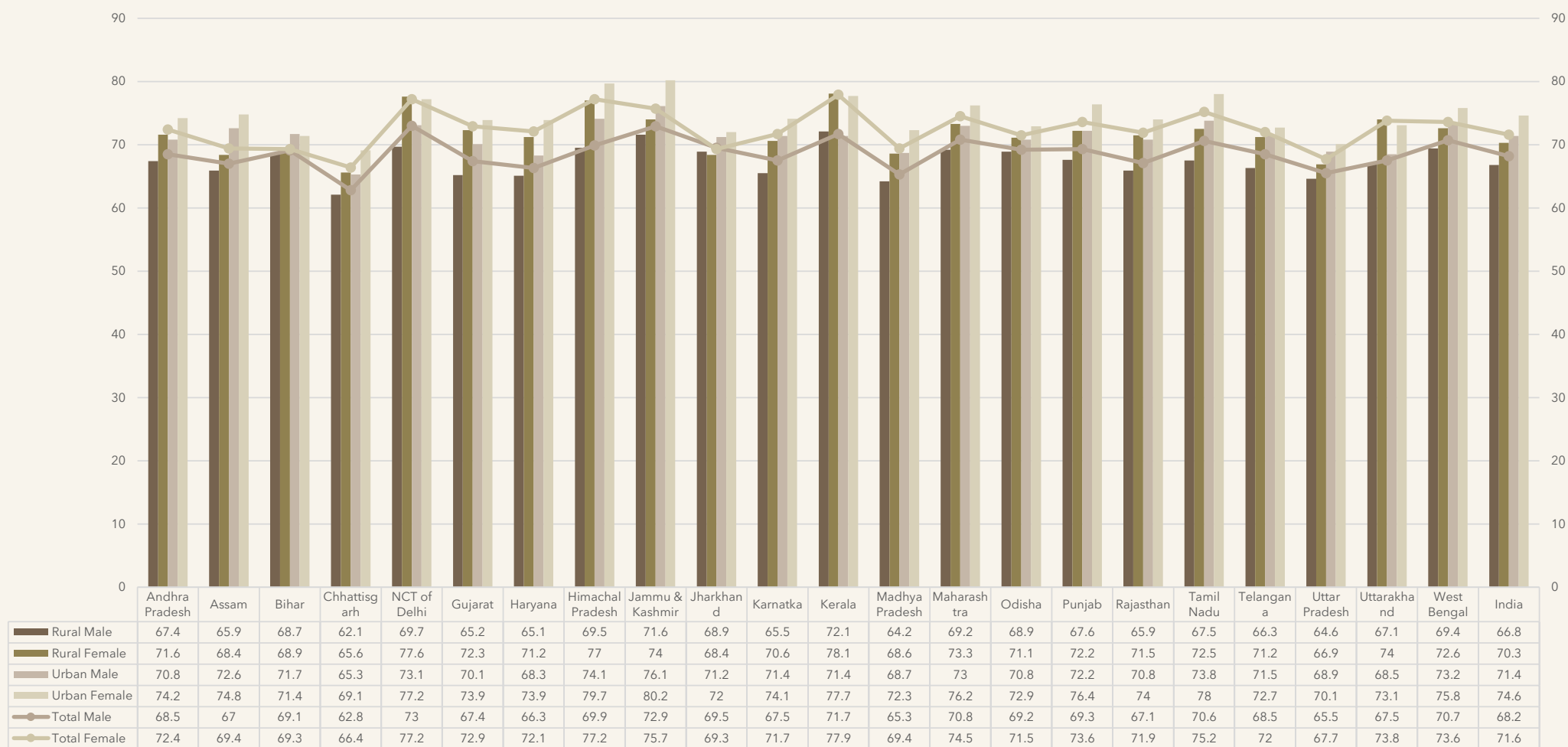
VITAL STATISTICS - 2022 BASED ON SAMPLE REGISTRATION SYSTEM BY RURAL AND URBAN AREAS



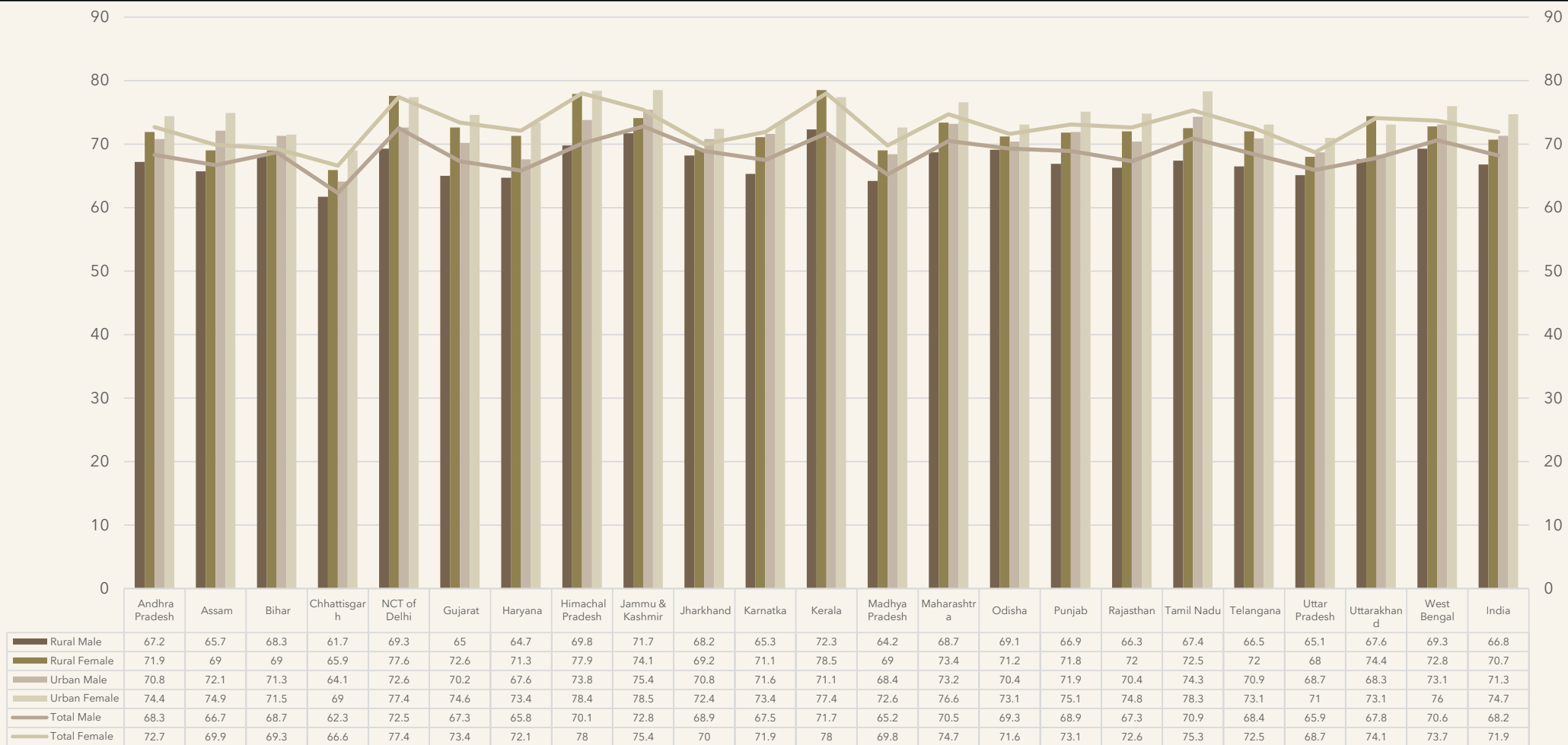
INFANT MORTALITY RATES BY RURAL AND URBAN AREAS DURING – 2022



EXPECTATION OF LIFE AT BIRTH BY SEX AND RESIDENCE, INDIA AND STATES/UTS, 2017-21



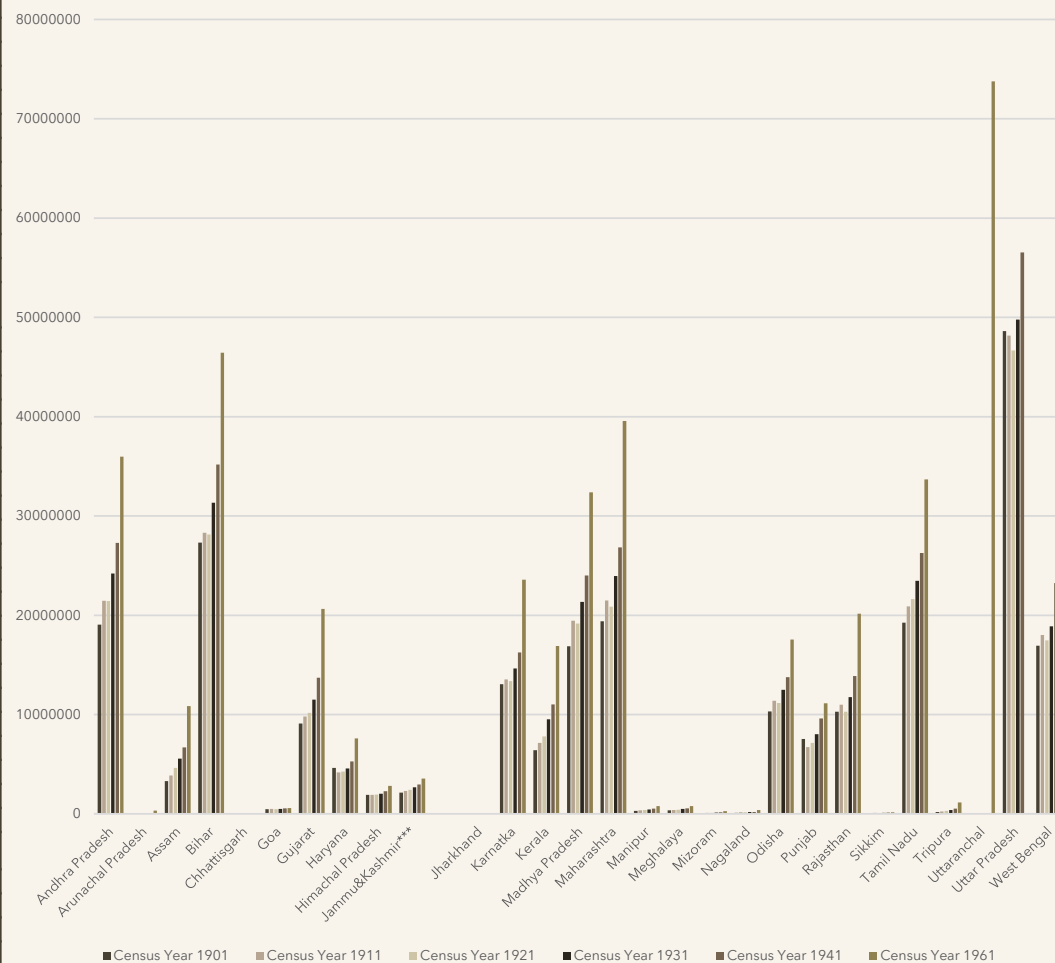

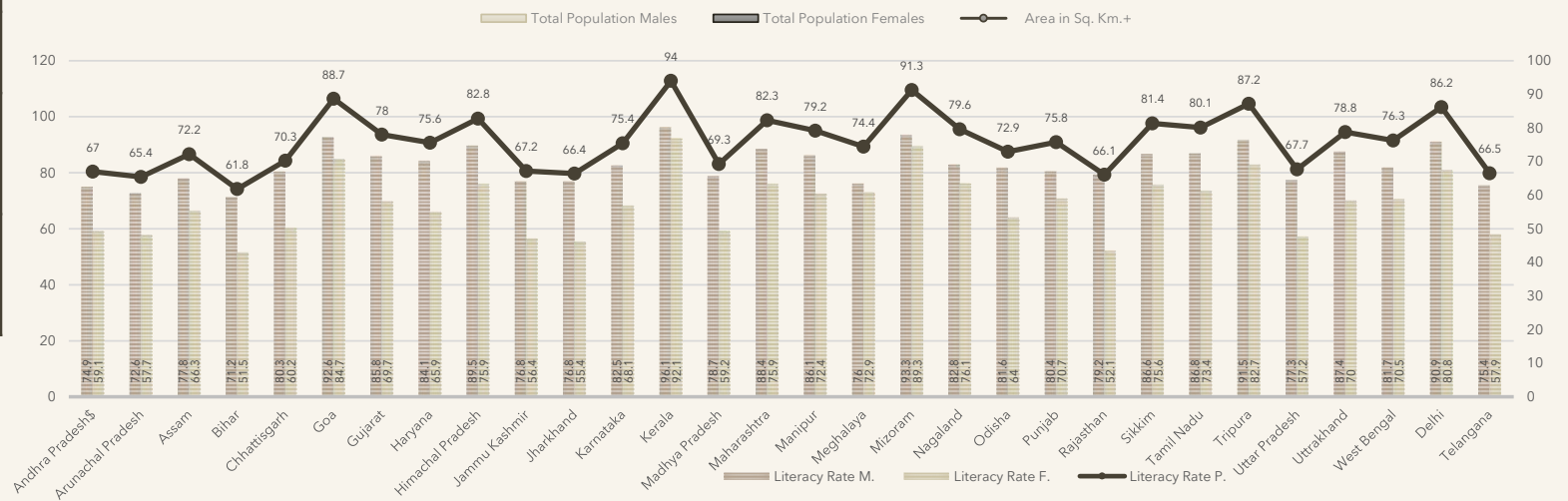
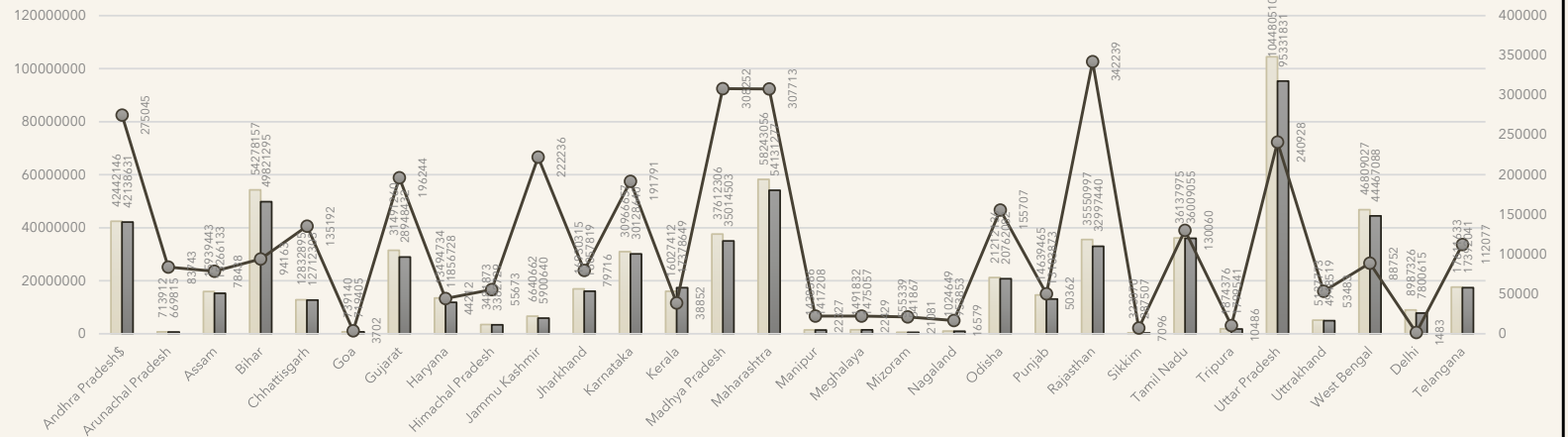
DENSITY OF POPULATION – INDIA AND STATES

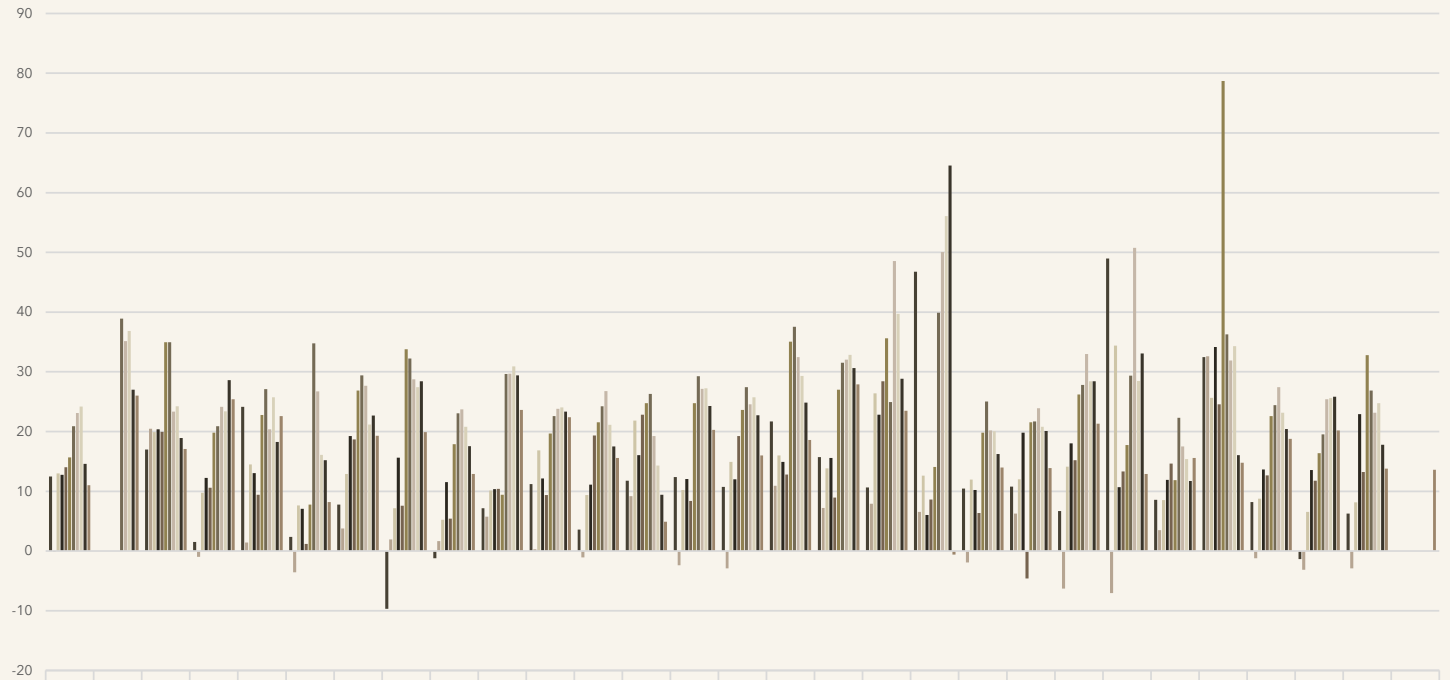
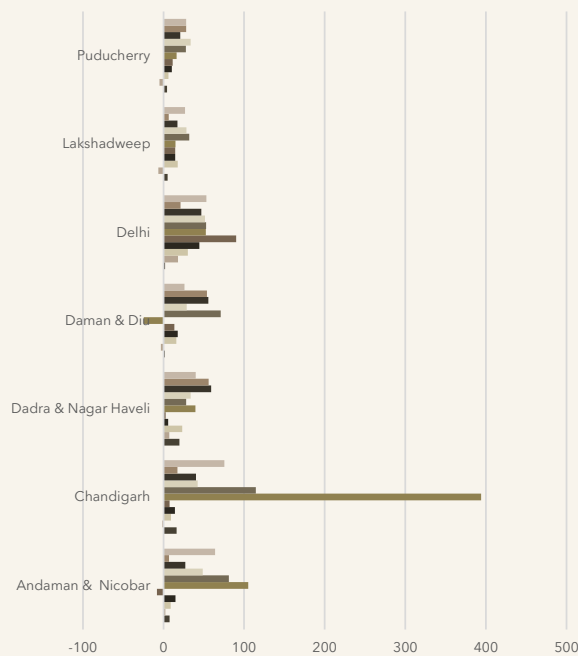
STATE-WISE POPULATION BY RELIGION (CENSUS 2011)

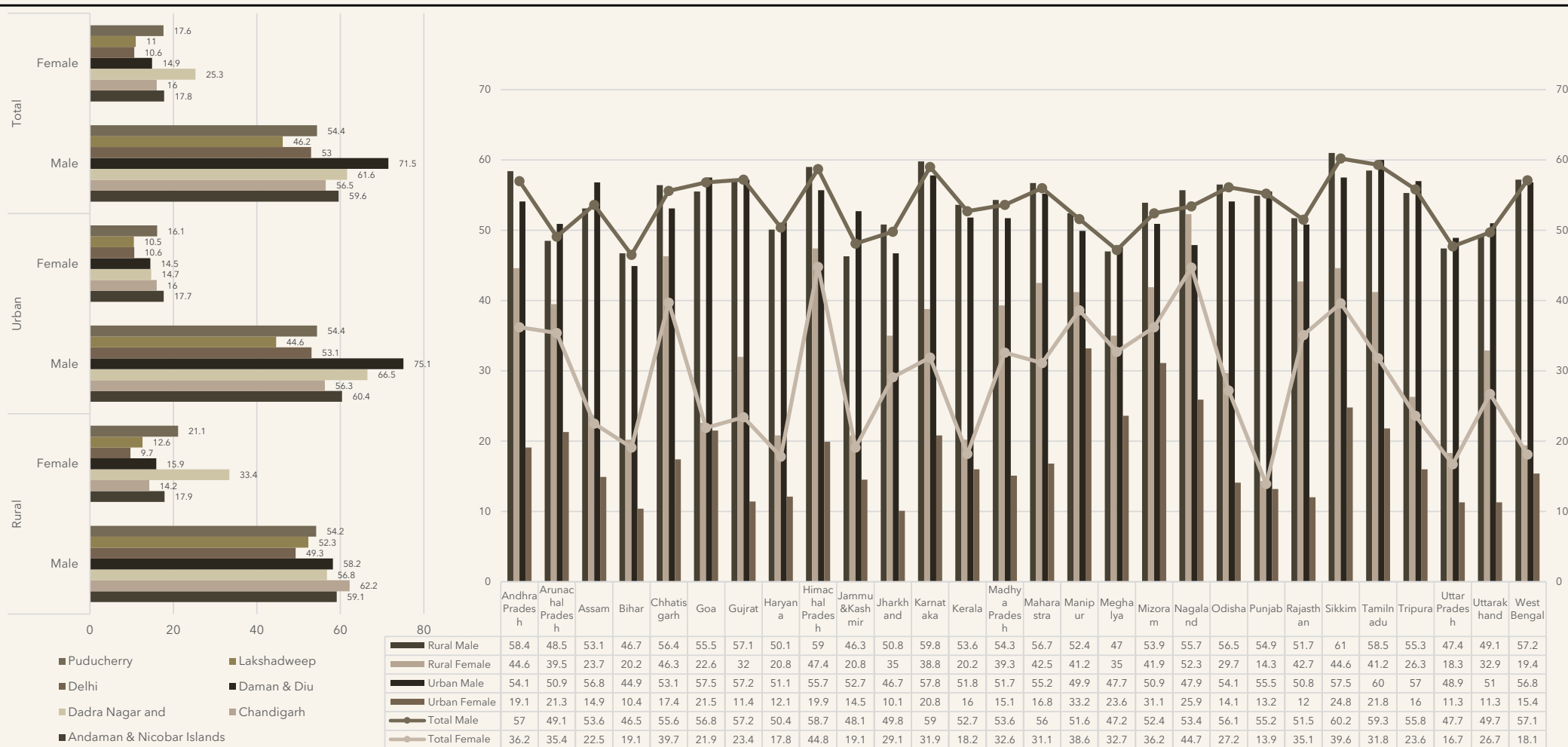
