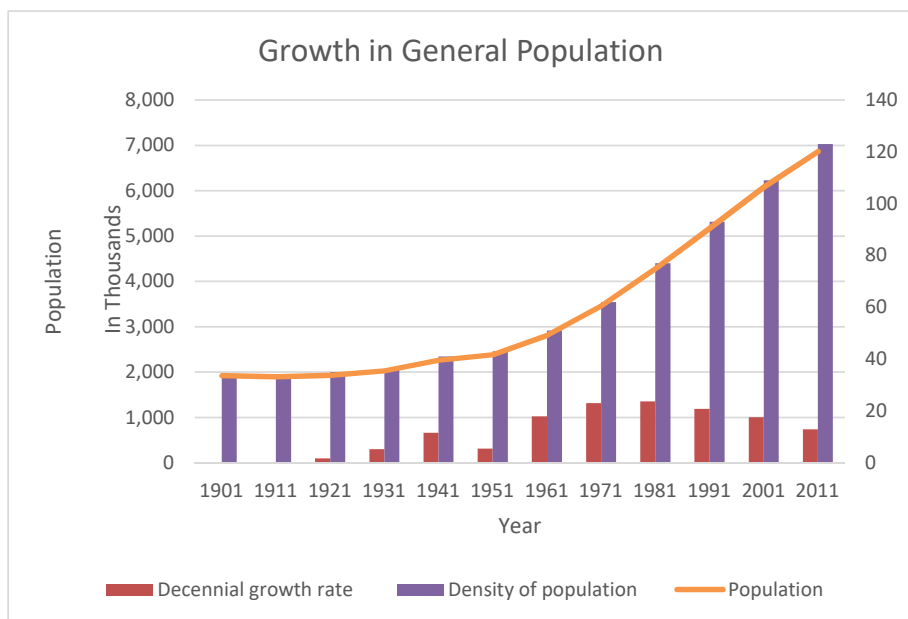

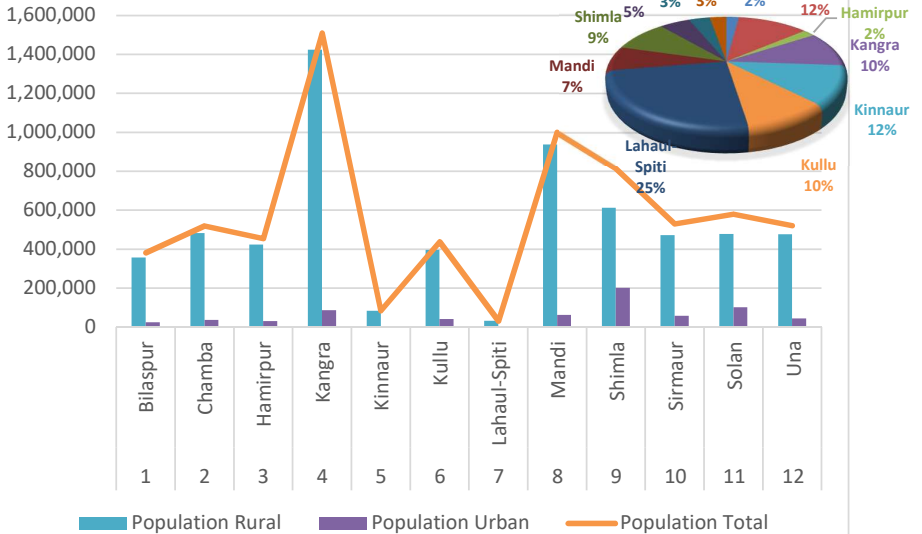

### District-wise Area Distribution-2011

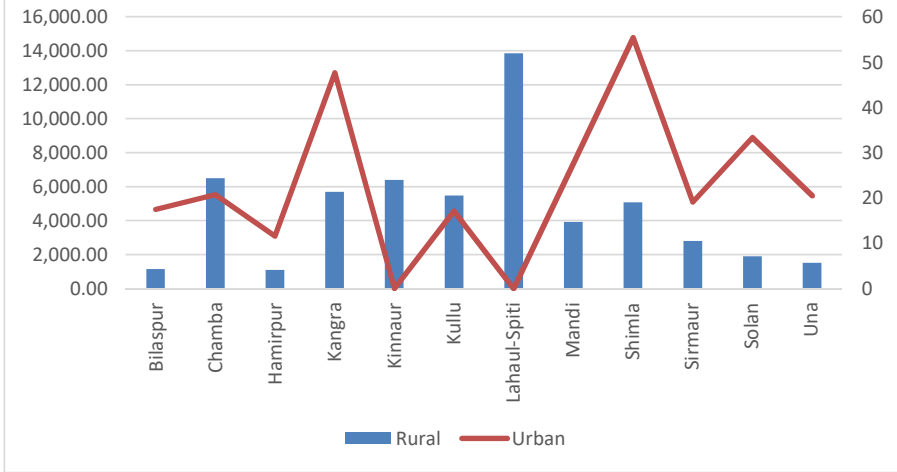

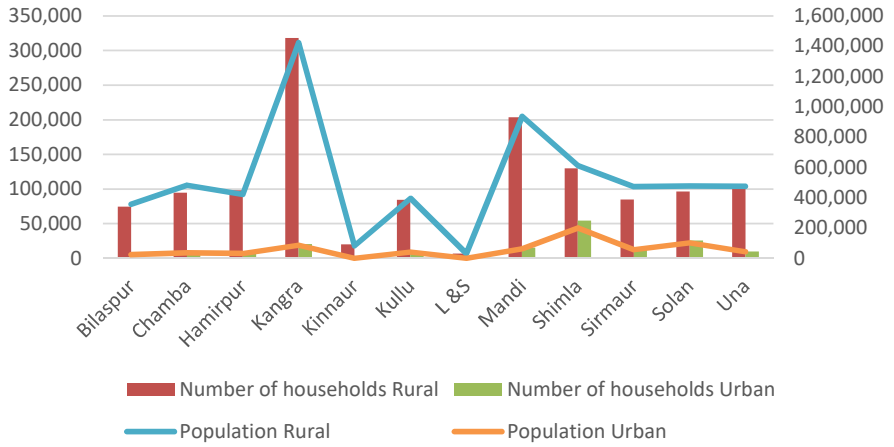

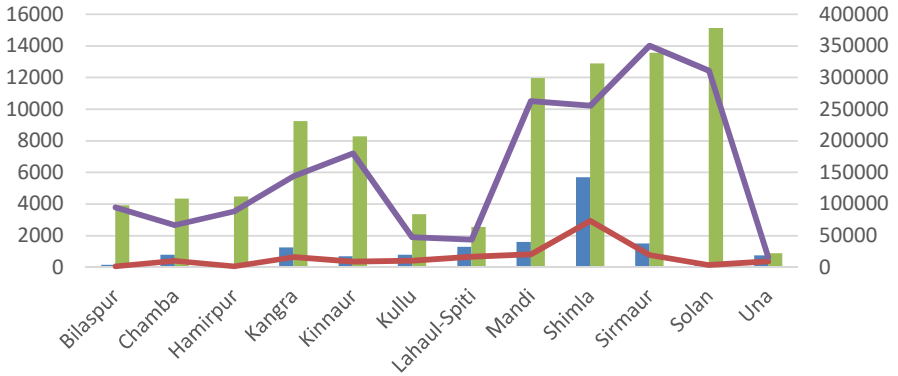

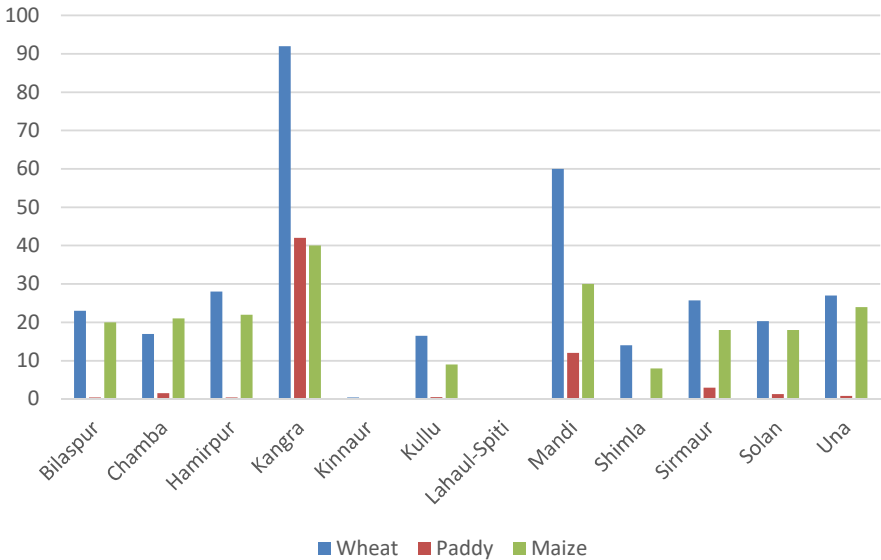

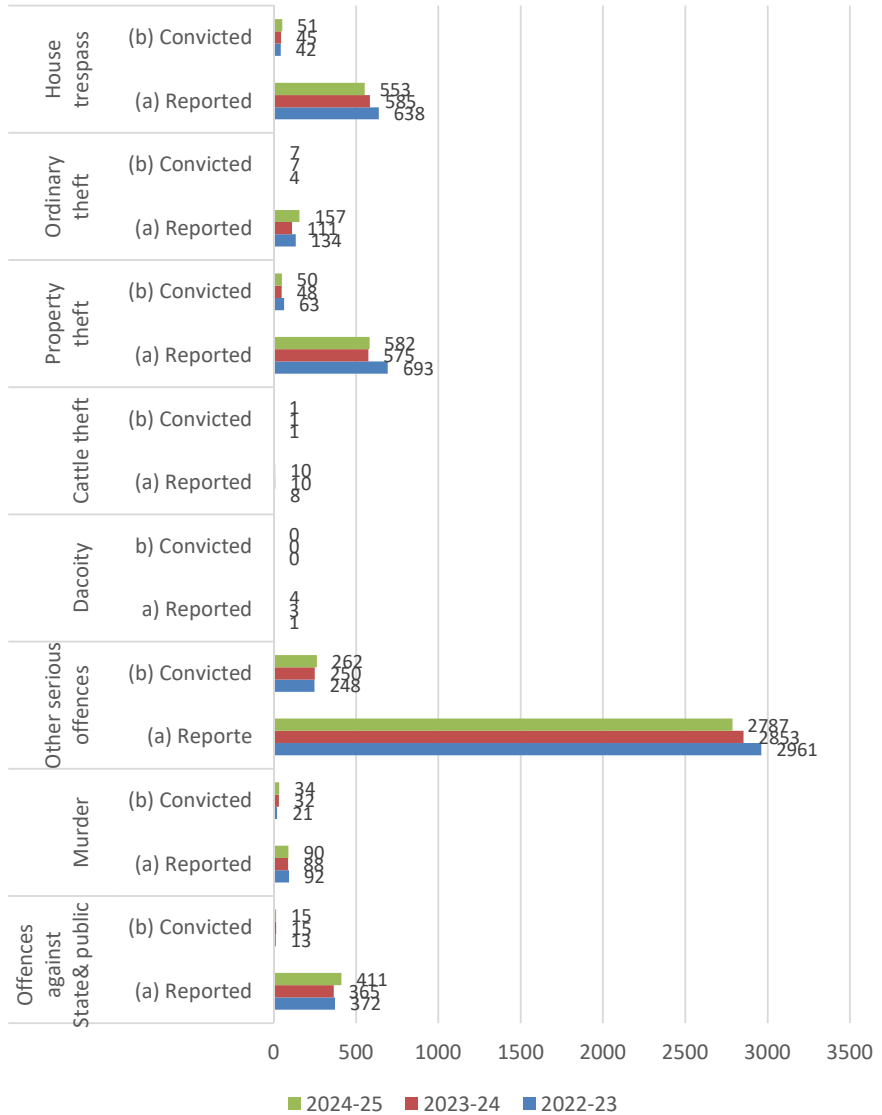
